Mustered in in Hilton Head, SC on Mar 8, 1865. Discharged on Oct 11, 1866 in Charleston, SC. Stephens' wife filed for a widows pension. In her application she stated the she was born on Daufuskie Island: she did not know when she was born, but during the Civil War she was a grown woman; she was owned by Copnrad Gordon who lived in Liberty Co. GA Her father was Bob Houston and mother was Peggy Houston. She was one of 8 brothers and 6 sisters, all who were dead as of 1924, except for Eliza Morrell, widow of Dr Morrell of Daufuskie Island, SC. Stephen and Elsie had 6 children (Abraham, Sandy, Dennis , Katherine and Reecca - all dead as of 1924; and William born Aug 27, 1871). She does not remember the dates of any of their children's birth, except the first 4 were born before the Civil War. They were married before the Civil War during slavery time. The date of Stephen's birth is not known; his mother was Charlotte Bacon. At the time that her pension application was filed in 1924, she had one grandson, Dennis Beacon, Jr. who was living in Daufuskie Island, SC.

USCT (some of the records of Campbell Co K 21st included in Campbell 128th Reg.). Sameul married Hester Fennick in the fall of 1866.

Service credited to the Town of Venice, Cayuga Co., NY. Jan. 1866 detailed as company cook. Mustered out at Charleston, SC on Oct 10, 1866. Violet claims in pension records that she is Perry's only wife. She arrived on Hilton Head Island in August 1867 after the soldier's mustered out. They were married Aug. 1868 by Rev. A. Murchison, a Negro preacher. They owned their own home plus 75 acres. Violet died on Jul 26, 1899.
