

Robert¹, John², John³, Henry⁴ Bedell Descent

First Generation

1. **Robert¹ Bedell** ^{1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12} was born in 1619. He died before 20 Mar 1702 in Hempstead, Nassau County, NY.

Robert resided 1654 - 1700 in Hempstead, Nassau County, NY.

The year of birth appears on a small diagram of the ancestors of Daniel Bedell, Robert's son. The diagram includes only Robert and Blanche. The diagram is not a highly regarded source, and no source is given. According to Ceylon H. Bedell [Ceylon H. Bedell, *Bedell Family Notes*, vol 1, Preface], "the name Bedell is traceable to very high antiquity. It has been variously spelled and pronounced. Bedell is the form we find it in the fifteenth century. Tradition tells us that three brothers came from Essex, England. One of them settled at Hempstead, Long Island, New York. From the latter the Bedell family of New York and particularly that of Dutchess County has descended." Peters, *Powells of the Mid-Hudson*, Bedell family title notecard, states that the Bedell family came from Cardiff, County Ganengan [Glamorgan], Principality of Wales.

Semon H. Springer, *Peter Cooper and Hempstead, 1812-1818*: Springer, writing in about the late 1940's, provides a detailed (and likely somewhat imagined historical account) of the courtship and early marriage of Peter Cooper and Sarah Bedell (father Benjamin, gfather Silvanus, ggfather Richard, gggfather Daniel, gggfather Robert). However, his names and dates are accurate. He states, "Sarah Bedell stemmed from one of the earliest settlers in Hempstead who came from France by way of Holland to the New Netherlands. Unlike the English settlers who came from Weathersfield, Connecticut with Richard Denton and Robert Fordham in 1643-1644, the progenitor of the Bedell clan had worked his way from New Amsterdam, stopping briefly in what is now Brooklyn and thence to Hempstead sometime prior to 1657. He was the first French Huguenot to reach Hempstead, many more soon followed."

Mack states that Robert and Blanch were married in 1647. The location of Robert prior to his identification as an inhabitant and townsman of Hempstead, Long Island, NY on 17 Mar 1657 is not known with certainty. However, it is likely that he came to Hempstead from Connecticut where he probably was one of the three Robert Bedells that appear in the records there. Margo Miller and the editors of this genealogy tentatively believe that he is the Robert Bedell in Connecticut who keeps cows for the Winthrops and records the same cattle mark as Robert of Hempstead is Robert Bedell of Hempstead.

Based on Bedell Family myths, the persistent story that Robert Bedell of Hempstead descendants are distantly related to Bishop William Bedell of Kilmore, Ireland, and the chronology of public and parish records, the authors concur in the research by Margo Miller that Robert Bedell of Connecticut and Hempstead is probably Robert Bedell of Fairstead, Essex, England who was baptized 1 Sep 1624. See the research paper "Early History of the Bedell Families" by Joseph C. Rhea, Mary Ellen (Bedell) Rhea, and Margo Miller. Further research is required to rule out other Robert Bedell candidates in England who would have been born about 1620.

No Bedell is listed in the settlement of the roughly twenty families who migrated to Hempstead, Long Island in the last of Nov 1641. Neither was a Bedell listed in the first division of land in the town of Hempstead in 1647 [Monnette, *First Settlers of Ye Plantations of Piscataway and Woodbridge, Olde East New Jersey, 1664-1714*, Part 2, p 163]. Robert Bedell and Blanch probably came to Hempstead as early as 1654 as evidenced by the following. In Volume 1 of the Hempstead Town Records (p. 112ff) an undated list of holdings of Hempstead men includes the name of Robert Bedell. This list was drawn up probably as early as Sep 1655 and may have been as early as 1654. The undated reply of Hempstead settlers to Governor Stuyvesant's demand for the "tenths", dated 4 Jul 1656, was signed by Robert Beadle who made his mark. The reply was probably made shortly after the demand was received.

In 1657, Robert Bedell owned 8 head of cattle and 6 gates . . . "at the neck." [Note: The town record spells gates as "gats," and this is misinterpreted by some researchers as "goats." Gates was a standard means of measuring the extent of farm property (usually for livestock enclosure) which was controlled by a tax payer. Six gates would signify a "middle class" holding (compared with 16 gates for the large land holder) and suggests that Robert was already well established by 1657, as does the 8 head of cattle.]

He was granted 16 acres by the town of Hempstead in 1657 and on 29 Nov 1658 he "concluded" to take up more land. It is likely that he held other land at this time as well, given the number of gates in the 1657 record. In 1658 his taxes were 28 shillings, a middle class assessment. [It should be noted here that the term "middle class" is deceptive since the greater share of townsmen had far less in holdings.] Among the "cows" kept by Spragg in 1658 were 5 that belonged to Robert. He was elected Goodman Bedell at a salary of 12 shillings per week.

The townsmen of Hempstead made an agreement with Robert "Beedle" on 25 Mar 1659 to the "effect that he take charge of ye west herd of cowes belonging to the town from May 1 on." The inhabitants were to send out their cows when Robert blew his horn and he would then take the herd to pasture when the sun was "a half hour above the horizon" and "return them a half-hour before sunset." He or his eldest son was to consider this his sole employment. His salary was 14 shillings per week. He was replaced by Walter Wall on 13 Apr 1660. There is a signature of a Robert Beadle recorded in the Hempstead Town Records, but this signature is probably that of Robert Bedell, Jr., or even of a later Robert.

On the last day of Feb 1660 the home-lot belonging to the town of Hempstead was leased at a general town meeting to Robert for 20 shillings. George Mills of Rusdorp sold his house, barn and home-lot in Hempstead and another adjoining it to Robert on 13 Dec 1661. George sold the remainder of his land to Thomas Ellison. Among the calves to be kept in the "north woods" in "the height of fly time" were 6 of Robert's. On 9 Feb 1663, Robert leased the home-lot belonging to the town house for 14 shillings. On 14 Jun 1665, Robert recorded the ownership of a mare marked with a half penny under each ear and on 13 Sep 1665 he sold a cow, marked the same way, to Ogdin Broun. This cattle mark with slight additions such as a slit in the off ear is used by his descendants for over a century.

Robert Bedell and William Thickstun each sold a cow to Aryn Lambartsun of "the flatbush" on 23 Jun 1666. During the year of 1667 Robert sold two cows and a mare, purchasers not known. The records of the house and land which Robert Beddell bought of Steaven Hudson, and the home-lot and house, formerly Hope Washburne's, which he purchased from George Hewlett and William Osborne are recorded in the Hempstead town books, 11 Dec 1667.

"Robert Beadle doth frely acknowledge that his wife Blanch Beadle shall have use and improvement of the house and land in this bill of sale (probably that formerly belonging to Washburne) her whole life time in case her husband die before her". This document was signed by Robert making his mark. Robert was witness to a deed of Thomas Iarland's [Ireland], 31 Mar 1668. On 11 Jan 1668, Robert was in Mr. Seaman's company to draw lots for land for planting. In the town meeting of 30 Jan 1668, he leased the "home lot" of the town for 16 shillings. On 3 Jun 1669, it was agreed that Goodman Bedle was to keep the east herd of cattle belonging to the town for 14 shillings per week, and on 19 Mar 1670 he began his "coucekeeping." Sometime during 1669 Robert recorded on the Hempstead town books his ownership of a lot at the "half neck" containing 4 acres and 69 1/2 rods.

Hempstead Town Records, vol 8, pp 130-132, includes an undated entry on page 9 of the "Book of Laws and Deeds" containing a list of 160 names, "The nams of those yt paid to ye pattin with ye number of aceres." The list, however shows the payment rather than the number of acres. Among them are "Robard bedel" who had the smallest payment of 3 1/2D compared to "James pine" who had the largest payment of 5 pounds [Thorn Dickinson, "Early History of the Thorne Family of Long Island"].

Robert bought the old town barn for 3 pounds on 22 Jun 1670, and the town house for 9 pounds on 25 Apr 1671. On 30 Jun 1671 Robert deeded a tract on "Cowes great neck", south of the town of Hempstead, to his obedient and loving sons, Daniel and John, husbandmen. Blanc Bedell signed the release as well, making her mark. On the same date, Robert sold to his son, Daniel, 3 acres and 1 square rod of land in the southern part of the town. It was formerly the property of Stephen Hudson. He also sold to Daniel 4 acres in "Half neck" north of land belonging to John Smith Rock, Jr. The Hempstead census of 1673 records Robert, Daniel, Matthew and John Bedell [Vanderkamp's Translation of Dutch Record, XXI]. The names of the same four appear in the town books on 8 Mar 1674 as leasing land from the town.

Orra Eugene Monnette, *First Settlers of Ye Plantations of Piscataway and Woodbridge Olde East New Jersey, 1664-1714*, part 1 (1930), pp 119-120; part 3, p 489: The name, Robert Bedell, appears in the list of First Settlers of Staten Island, Richmond County, NY with the year of 1673. Quoting from Manor, pp 251 and 253, Monnette records: "Early in the period of English control, Long Island, Staten Island and Westchester were all classified as the three Ridings of Yorkshire. Suffolk was called the East Riding, King's County, part of Queen's and Staten Island made up the West Riding; the remainder of Queen's and Westchester made up the North Riding. In 1683, however, the Assembly abolished the Ridings and established Counties in their stead, directing that the County of Richmond should 'conteyne all Staten Island, Shutter's Island, and the islands of meadow on the west side thereof. But long before this -- in 1675, to be exact -- a Court of Assizes held in New York ordered that 'by reason of the separation by water, Staten Island shall have jurisdiction by itself, and have no further dependence on the Courts of Long Island, nor on its militia.' Ever since then Staten Island has been an independent judicial district."

At a court held by the constable and overseers of Hempstead, 7 Apr 1675, Henry Boman alleged that Robert Bedell owed him for cow keeping. The Court ordered the defendant to pay the remainder of the money yet unpaid for six cows according to the rate. On 5 May 1675, in Court Tomas Ellison brings suit against Robert claiming he had a company of "Mat" Bedell's cattle for three or four days and that he should have been paid 3 shillings a day for his service. Robert Bedell was named the defendant because, Ellison alleged, that Robert promised to pay the charge if Matthew did not, and that neither had done so. The court awarded 12 shillings to Ellison [Onderdonk, *The Annals of Hempstead*, pp 28-29].

At court held on 2 Jun 1675, Robert Jackson entered an action of the case against John Junnins, a settler with whom the Bedells had several legal disputes. Robert, Matthew, John, and "Betty" [probably Robert's daughter, Elizabeth] testified for the plaintiff. The case was thrown out of court.

In the town meeting of 9 Apr 1677, Robert and Daniel Bedell were among the proprietors of Hempstead empowered to take up 100 acres of woodland each, except Daniel was limited to a half-share [50 acres]. On 20 Jun 1679, Robert Bedell at a town meeting was given 50 acres and Daniel 25 acres, as proprietors of Hempstead.

On 1 Sep 1681 "Robert Bedle, Senr, of Hempstead" conveyed to his son, Robert the elder's "now dwelling house witt home lott and orchard and all housing barns". Robert, Jr. was not to take possession until his father's decease, and he was to allow his mother, Blanch, to dwell there during her lifetime, should her husband precease her. She was to have use of the orchard whenever she wished. Robert deeded to his son-in-law, "Charls Abrams," on 26 Nov 1681, a howllo on Hempstead Plain. On 5 Jan 1682, Robert, Sr. sold to Richard Minthorne all his right in the east "ox pasture" consisting of 4 "ox gattes".

The inhabitants of Hempstead on 24 May 1682 agreed to maintain Jeremy Hubbard as minister. Contributions to his yearly support from the Bedells was Robert (1 pound), Daniel (1 pound), John (10 shillings), Matthew (5 shillings), and Robert, Jr. (5 shillings). The contributions could be made in corn or cattle. On 11 Oct 1683, Robert Beagle, Sr. was recorded as having 3 cows and 3 sheep in the evaluation of the estates of Hempstead inhabitants [Carol M. Meyers, *Rate Lists of Long Island, 1675, 1676, and 1683*. Saugus, CA: RAM Publishers, 1967, p 74]. His sons owned 35 1/2 acres of "land and meadows". Thomas Ellison of Hempstead conveyed to John Tredwell a meadow lot on the west side of "cose Neck" on 16 Nov 1683. This meadow was bounded on the south end by a "whit oak tree next ye woods adjoining to goodman Begles fence". By a vote of the town Simon Garman [Jarman, Jerman; later to become Germond] was given about 1 1/2 acres south of Jeremiah Wood's and "near his father bedle" on 22 Jun 1685. Simon was married to Robert's daughter, Mary.

On 14 Apr 1685 Thomas Higam of Hempstead sold to Robert Bedle his "now dwelling house and home lot" consisting of about 3 acres and located east of Daniel Bedle's 50-acre lot. It is not certain that this sale was to Robert, Sr., but most references to Robert's son, Robert are made as Robert, Jr. A deed of John Ellison's on 23 Feb 1687 contains a notice of a lot that had been sold by his father, "Laranc Ellison" to Robard Bedle, Sener. On 1 Mar 1686 Robert Bedel, Sener deeded certain property in Hempstead to Elias Doughty. On 7 Apr 1686 Robert Bedel, Sener made a gift to his son John of the house and lot where the latter was then dwelling, the said property being east of Daniel's land and west of Robert's.

Cornell, *Genealogy of the Cornell Family*, p 147: The will of Richard Cornell of Rockaway, dated 7 Nov 1693, proved 30 Oct 1694 gives to his son, Thomas, "a tract bounded south by William [Cornell], north

by the middle of the fresh cove that Robert Beadel's meadow was laid out in . . ."

On 6 Feb 1694, Robert is a witness to the will of Harmon Flower of Hempstead [Jamaica Wills, Liber A, p 93].

Robert, Sr., Daniel and John Bedell were among the proprietors of Hempstead to whom John Stuard addressed his petition for a grant of 18 or 20 acres on 16 Feb 1692. On 3 Apr 1697, Robert Beedel, Sener, planter, conveyed to his son Robert 1/4 of the meadow on Coes Neck, Bounded westerly by Hicks Neck Creek, northerly by Thomas Ellison's land, and easterly by land of John Smith, Rock. In the census of 1698 for Hempstead, Robert's name occurs immediately before that of his son, John, suggesting that he might have been living with John at that time.

Treadwell in Additions and Corrections to the New York Genealogical and Biographical Record Articles does not believe that Robert Beadle or Bedell of Wethersfield, CT and/or New London, CT are identical. Robert of Wethersfield was a felon and Robert of Hempstead was a townsman and quite respectable. See Early History of the Bedell Families research paper. Mack references a Genealogy of the Bedell Family that is in the Queens Borough Public Library, but our research there as failed to discover it. Mack states that Robert and Blanch had a son, David, born 1648, who married in 1679 Anne Pawlett. Mack records this son as the father of Richard, rather than Daniel.

Robert died between the Hempstead census of August 1698 and 20 March 1702 when an inventory was taken of his estate, since he died intestate. His son, Daniel, was appointed administrator of his father's estate, 28 May 1702. The inventory of his estate was taken by John Sering and Thomas Gildersleeve. Items in the inventory and their value included:
1 bed and bedding (2 pounds, 14 shillings), clothing (4 pounds, 12 shillings), 1 chest (12 shillings), 1 ox (4 pounds, 15 shillings), 1 cow and calf (3 pounds, 6 shillings), 2 farrow cows (5 pounds, 6 shillings), 2 steers and half a yearling (6 pounds, 6 shillings), Dan Beedle debter for rent for cattle and meadow (4 pounds, 16 shillings), John Beedle bond(10 pounds), and two cows and calves (2 pounds and 18 shillings).

Robbert Beedil listed in Myers, Early New York State Census Records, "Names of People in Hempstead, Long Island, 1673."

Bedell Vertical Files, NYGBS Library, reviewed 9 Nov 1999: Genealogy Chart states 1671 deed by Robert to sons Daniel and John lists Blanche as his wife.

Edna Johnson Bedell, Bedell Genealogy, p 5: "Robert was doubtless born in England before 1620, as the birthdate of his son, Matthew – who was not his eldest – can be placed about 1645. Probably married prior to 1644 his wife Blanche.

Edwin Salter, A History of Monmouth and Ocean Counties, p viii: "In Topanemus graveyard is a tombstone erected to Jeremiah Bedle, who died in 1732, aged 79 years." [Assuming the reading of the tombstone is correct, Jeremiah would have been born in 1652 or 1653. Chronologically, Jeremiah would fit as a heretofore unidentified son of Robert. There is no mention in any Hempstead records of Jeremiah as a son of Robert. However, the appearance of the given name, Jeremiah, as a grandson of Robert and son of Daniel suggests that the name was used by Robert as a name of one of his children. However, an alternative explanation exists. Jeremiah may have been an early immigrant of the Bedle family from the West Indies, the ancestral origin of Joseph Bedle, a Governor of New Jersey.]

Robert married Blanch(e) ^{13,14,15,16,17,18,19} in 1647. Blanch(e) died before Sep 1698.

First called Robert's wife 11 Dec 1667, but probably was married to her before 1644. Blanche died between 1 Sep 1681 and Aug 1698 since her name does not appear in the Hempstead 1698 census. Jim Sabin in his Family Group Sheets on file at the Greene County, NY Historical Library has a last

name for Blanche of King with a ? mark, with her father listed as "Robert King?" There was a Robert King in Hempstead Long Island, but he did not have a child named Blanche. Robert King was from Weymouth, Dorset County, England. Bedell Family Descendents List spells given name Blanche.

New England Marriages Prior to 1700 reports, erroneously, her date of birth as 1644.

Second Generation

John² Bedell^{1,2,3,4,5,6,7} [Robert (1)] was born^{8,9} in 1650 in Hempstead, Queens County, NY. He died^{10,11,12} before 3 Apr 1716 in Hempstead, Queens County, NY.

John resided 1650 - 1716 in Hempstead, Nassau County, NY.

John's birth date is ca. 1650, or a little before. The first Hempstead record of him is 13 Mar 1660 in the will of John James [see below]. One source indicates that John was born in 1679 and that Sarah was Abt 1683 in Leyden, Holland, but this is obviously in error. John and Sarah are listed in the Hempstead 1698 census with the first five of their children, John, Jr., Samuel, Jacob, Benjamin, and Martha [NYGB Record, vol 45, p 57]. On 30 Jun 1671, John (with his brother Daniel) is described as a "husbandman" when he and his brother were deeded a tract of land by his father. John Beddell is listed in Myers, Early New York State Census Records, "Names of People in Hempstead, Long Island, 1673."

In Pearsall, et. al., The Pearsall Family, p 1055: "In 1671 Capt. John Seaman rented all the meadow from the foot of the beach extending to Widow Pearsall's lot, and in 1672 James Pine rented the same described as the common meadow at Rockaway from the beach foot to Widow Pearsall's lot, and in 1673, John Bedell rented this peace of meadow, and Thomas Hicks rented it in 1675."

On 3 Mar 1674, John Bedle entered an action of debt against William Wieare for a "bridill." The court orders Weir to pay as good a bridle as he borrowed, or else pay three shillings, and charges [Onderdonk, The Annals of Hempstead, 1643-1832, p 28]. On 4 Apr 1677 John Bedell sued Timothy Halstead and

Samuel Denton for the value of 2 loads of hay which the defendants burned accidentally. It was agreed between the parties that the defendants would provide Bedell with two loads of fresh hay and that each of the parties would pay their own charges [Onderdonk, *The Annals of Hempstead*, p 31]. At a town meeting 5 Aug 1678 John Bedel was granted a 3 acre home lot. On 1 Mar 1682, John Bedell declares that Joseph Langdon owes him 2 shillings, 6 pence for killing and dressing a cow for him. The Court found in favor of Langdon and ordered John to pay charges. In the evaluation of estates of inhabitants of Hempstead, 11 Oct 1683, John Beedle owned 3 acres of land and meadows, 4 oxen, 2 cows, 6 head of other cattle, and 1 horse.

On 22 Dec 1684, John registered his ear mark as "a half penni of ye under side of ye near ear and a half penni of ye upper side of ye off ear." During 1684 John bought a heifer marked with "a half penni of ye under side of ye near ear and a half penni of ye upper side of ye off ear." On 17 Apr 1688 Thomas Ireland of Hempstead sold to Joseph a 3-acre home lot in the "sout est part of town" bound northerly by John Bedle's land. The names of John Bedle, wife Sarah, and children John, Jr., Samuel, Jacob, Benjamin, and Martha were listed in the Hempstead Census for 1698.

Edna Johnson Bedell, *Bedell Genealogy*, p 6: "From Huguenot -- 1698. Bayles, *Staten Island History*, p 92: 'To all Christiane peepell, To whome Theas present wrighting shall come John Benealle Seaniore of the County of Richmond and province of new york weaver and hester his wife --- convey with John Bevealle, etc. -- a certain trakt on the west side of stanoes Island near the fresh killes --- by the lynes of frances cseltone - Abraham Lacmons -- John Bevealle gives one A [acre] of land to the french congreygashone to build a church. signed in the presence of Jacob Corbett, D Lucas, Jeyn La Tourritte, Joseph Bastidoe, Samuel Grasset.' In 1695 a church was mentioned, p 94 describes location and centery. The french church in 1717 united with English and Dutch." [ed. note: If Benealle/Bevealle is another spelling for Bedell, then, given the year of this record of 1698, it is possible that the record refers to this John Bedell, although it would be the first mention of his activity outside of Hempstead.]

John Bedele witnessed a deed dated 9 Nov 1700 executed by Thomas Jecocks to David Jecocks. On 26 Dec 1709, John conveyed to his son, Samuel 25 acres of land in the "South Woods of Hempstead."

David Bedell was a witness [Libre B, No 2, Deeds, Register's Office, Queens County, NY]. Rober Williams was authorized by Hempstead on 5 Feb 1711 to lay out a highway between his lot, located south of "the parsonage and town lots," and John Beadle's lot.

John's last will was dated 26 Feb 1716 and probated 3 Apr 1716. In the will, John mentions his wife, Sarah, and children, John, Samuel, Jacob, Benjamin, Martha, Elizabeth, and Phebe. All of the daughters have surnames of Bedell in the will. He describes himself as "yeoman" and "aged." Job Bedell witnessed the will making his mark [Libre B, Wills, Register's Office, Queens County, NY, p 73; see also Eardley, *County Clerk Records, Jamaica*, p 68]. A transcript of the will states that it appears in Liber C, p 73. Text of the will is as follows:

"In the name of God Amen the 26th day of February in ye year of our Lord 1715/16 I John Beadle, Senior of Hempstead in Qqueens County in the Province of New York yeoman, being aged and weak in body but of tolerable sound mind and memory thanks be to God therefore do make and ordain this my last will and testament, that is to say I recommend my soul to God who gave it to me, my body to the dust after a Christian burial in a decent manner. As for such worldly goods whereas it has pleased God to bless me I give dispose and devise of the same in ye following manner and form. Imprimus -- I give to my well beloved wife Sarah my now dwelling house to live in during her naturall life and also a third of the whole of my lands at Town and south to be improved on her behalf and for the maintinence during her naturall life, also I give and bequeath to my said beloved wife Sarah one third of my moveable estate to be freely enjoyed by her for her own proper use and behalf. Item -- I give and bequeath to my four loving sons John, Sam'll, Jacob and Benjamin, then their heirs and assigns forever all my meadow at south to be equally divided between my said four sons as aforesaid. Item -- I give and bequeath to my loving sons, Jacob and Benjamin them their heirs and assigns forever all my lands at town and south as also my now dwelling house after the decease of my wife -- the said lands house barn and fences to be freely possessed and enjoyed by my said sons Jacob and Benjamin them their heirs and assigns forever, except one third of the said lands willed to my beloved wife Sarah during her naturall life, the said lands to be equally divided between my said sons Jacob and Benjamin. Also it is my will and desire that my said sons Jacob and Benjamin fit and repair my now dwelling house for their mothers comfort and benefitt. Item -- I give my loving daughter Martha 1 pewter platter and 1 beacon. Item -- I give and bequeath to my loving sons Jacob and Benjamin and to my loving daughters Elizabeth and Phebe the two remaining thirds of my moveable estate to be equally divided. . . . I ordain my beloved

Sarah Executrix revoking all other Wills and testaments." Witnesses Daniel Thurston, Thomas Spragg, and Job Beadle. No inventory was filed.

The will of John James of Cardiffe, county Glamorgan, Principality of Wales, dated 13 Mar 1660 devises to John Beadle "my Doublet and black cloth breeches and 40 shillings his father owes me to keep him in school". John James was town clerk of Hempstead from 1657 through 1659. [W. S. Pelletreau, *Wills of the Smith Families of New York and Long Island*, New York, 1898, p 119; Bunker, *Long Island Genealogies*, p 172.]

Some researchers believe that John James was the progenitor of John Beadle because of his mention in the will. Others discount that the mention of John in the will is to another John Beadle because John is so young at the time the will is made. When this provision of the will is properly interpreted, as a bequest in forgiveness of a debt owed by John's father, these two assumptions can be seen as errors.

John married^{18,19} **Sarah Southard**^{13,14,15,16,17} in 1679 in Hempstead, Queens County, NY. Sarah was born²⁰ about 1662. She died after 1716.

Sarah's surname may be Southward. She was the daughter of Thomas and Annica (Jansen) Southard and grand-daughter of Anthony and Grielje Jansen [W. D. A. Eardeley, *Records in the Office of the County Clerk at Jamaica, NY*, p 68. 1918 booklet in the Main Branch of the New York Public Library]. She was living as late as 26 Feb 1715/6 [the date of John's will].

Her approximate date of death is taken from a Tredwell note on file at the NYGBS Library.

Third Generation

John³ Bedell ^{1,2,3,4,5,6,7} [Robert (1), John (2)] was born⁸ in 1684. He died⁹ on 2 Jan 1759 in Elizabethtown, Union County, NJ.

John resided in Elizabeth Twp, Morris County, NJ. He resided in Turkey, Union County, NJ. He resided in New Providence, Union County, NJ.

"The Descendents of John Bedell who lived in the Passaic Valley, NJ," by Edwin Bedell, 22 pp. (1885): Edwin Bedell gives as the sources for his booklet, John Littel's "Family Records and Genealogies of the First Settlers of the Passaic Valley," and the Bible that was owned by Mary Osborne who married Abraham Bedell in 1776. Other facts and dates were obtained from the descendants of Sarah Bedell Meeker in Seneca County, NY, and members of the Bedell family now living in the vicinity of New York City. Edwin Bedell relates the following historical background:

" . . . It seems that about 1665, Philip Carteret, Governor of New Jersey, sent messengers through all the adjoining provinces to invite settlers. This resulted in bringing many, and a number of inhabitants [from] a town in New England. . . . [They sent] a committee to examine the land in New Jersey, with the view of settling in that colony. The report of this committee must have been favorable to New Jersey, as about 500,000 acres of land were purchased from the Indians, and eighty families, some of whom came from Long Island, but the majority came from New England, who had organized as the "Elizabethtown Associates," assumed the ownership. The land having been surveyed, plots were sold to the members, who soon after took possession.

"In 1699 another survey was made of the "common" land, and other plots were sold. Fifty years later, that is about 1750, we find that John Bedell owned 100 acres of land, No. 21 (addition), of the Elizabethtown Survey, and also 114 acres, No. 20 (addition), lying North in the next tier of lots extending into the Great Swamp, and lived in what is now Morris County, in the place that was occupied by Isaac Crane in 1850.

"The land owned by John Bedell was a part of that which was sold in 1699, but the fact that there were several other Bedell families there in 1750, leads to the conclusion that the Bedells were among the first settlers."

Wardwell states that John may have moved to NJ before 1722 [Tredwell, Additions and Corrections]. Tredwell [in the NYGB Record articles, vol 71, p 146] thought that the designation "son of Joseph" added to the name of John indicated John's presence in Hempstead in 1722, but Wardwell suggested to Tredwell that the suffix might have been added because of the youthfulness of John [Tredwell, Additions and Corrections].

Tredwell in the Robert of Hempstead articles, NYGB Record, vol 71, p 146 notes that this John Bedell was father of another John, whose eldest child was born ca. 1726. He suggests that the first John was related to Henry and Benjamin. Since John had a brother Benjamin, and Benjamin's name is not mentioned in Hempstead records either after 3 Mar 1726, the assumption that John Bedell and Benjamin Bedell moved to NJ and are identical with the John and Benjamin identified by Edwin Bedell is supported. [See also NYGB Record, vol 71, p 147.] Henry moved to Georgia, although at present there is no further record of him except as given in his record. In his Additions and Corrections, Tredwell is definite regarding the move to New Jersey.

John was probably born between 1680 and 1686 in Hempstead. The first record of John occurs in the Hempstead Town Records on 20 Nov 1710 when "John Beadle Ju" recorded his cattle mark as "a half penny on the uper [sic] side of the right ear and a half penny and a nick under the left ear." [HTR vol 2, p 146.] He was a resident of Hempstead on 1 June 1722 [HTR vol 2, p 222]. After 1738, when a John

Bedell was listed as a private in Capt. Jacob Hikes' Queens County Company of Militia, the name John Bedell does not appear again in Hempstead records until mid-century. [NYG&B Record, vol 71, pp 145-147.] John was in New Jersey by 13 Apr 1740 when Jonathan Mulford purchased from John Pierson land adjoining John Bedell's. [Typed deed, p. 27, in folder "Bible Records, Vital Records, Deeds, etc. compiled by Mabel Day Parker at the Joint Free Public Library of Morristown and Morris Township.]

Gardner's Notes, Alexander Library, Rutgers University: May 1751, Samuel Burge and John Bedell of Morris County, yeomen. Deft.? delivered to bail? to Thomas Kinnan of said County response on breach of covenant, pleads not guilty [NJSCF: 1921]. Aug 1752 Morris County Freeholder's List identifies John Beadel and Jacob Beadle in Morris Twp [NJPRO].

John's date of death is calculated from Littell's genealogy [Edwin Bedell in his booklet, and Littell in Genealogies of the First Settlers of Passaic Valley, p 41, gives date of death as 2 Jan 1768] and the date his will was probated. John Jr.'s will was dated 19 Aug 1758 [New Jersey Archives, 1st Series, vol 32, p 25] and proved 31 May 1759. [Queensborough Bedell Genealogy states that the will was proved 5 Jul 1759; see the will in New York Historical Society Collections, 1896, p 321.] The place of death is from a Tredwell note on file at the NYGBS Library. His will names his wife, Ann, and six children [John, Jacob, Henry (absent), Mary Cannan, Sarah Lee and Phebe Tomkins]. Also mentioned are his wife's parents, Peter and "Mrs. Runion". To his son, John, he left his undivided land on Long Island and in New Jersey. To Jacob, John bequeathed the homestead in "Turkie" [Turkey, now New Providence, NJ]. John left Henry a part of his son's bequest "if he returns." The will also names two grandchildren, John (son of Henry) and Catherine Bedle. Executors named in the will are Ann, Jacob and John. [Colonial History of the State of New Jersey, First Series vol 32, Calendar of New Jersey Wills, Administrations, Etc., 1751-1760, vol 3 (1924), p 25.]

John lived first in Turkey [now New Providence] and later in Elizabeth Township, Morris County. The farm in Morris County was 60 acres adjoining the Passaic River, four miles below the Forks. It was located 1 1/2 miles from New Providence, and was 9 miles south of the Morristown Turkey Meeting House Graveyard. There is an unconfirmed LDS Ancestral File record of a John Bedell, b. abt 1714 in Woodbridge, Middlesex County, NJ who married aft 1750 in Woodbridge, NJ Anne Layton Bedell Runyon who was b. 1717 in Woodbridge, Middlesex County, NJ. Another report identifies a John Bedell, b. 1701 in Piscataway, Middlesex, NJ who married Ann Runyon, b. 15 Aug 1705 in Piscataway, Middlesex, NJ, d. Bef Jan 1759 in NJ. According to this latter report, Ann was a twin. The dates of birth for these reports are probably confused with those of John, Jr.'s son, John.

Gale Burwell in the introduction to The Descendents of John Bedell of New Jersey states, "the New Jersey Bedells were written up in Family Records or Genealogies of the First Settlers of Passaic Valley, by John Littell in 1852; The Descendants of John Bedell, by Edwin Bedell in 1885; and in "Jersey Genealogies" appearing in the Newark Evening News in 1912. However, to the best of my knowledge, no one has sorted out the three New Jersey documents and published a clear record of this New Jersey branch of the Hempstead family." This was Gale Burwell's purpose in developing her Descendents of John Bedell. Much of what we have recorded in the descendents of this John Bedell is due to her work.

Orra Eugene Monnette, First Settlers of Ye Plantations of Piscataway and Woodbridge Olde East New Jersey, 1684-1714, Part 3, p 552: John Beedle is included in the List of the Freeholders In the County of Essex, 1 Sep 1755.

There were several other Bedell families in Morris County in 1750. Benjamin Bedell and Henry Bedell owned farms in the vicinity of New Providence, and both of them left children. There was also Jacob Bedell who apparently died childless. Jacob's widow died on 9 Sep 1773.

John married (1) Mary Linnington ¹⁰ about 1705.

[This note by Gale Burwell in The Bedell Family.] "A handwritten manuscript by a Sarah C. Bedell around the late 1800's or early 1900's states that John Bedell married Mary Linnington. Research by Richard McCool does not confirm this marriage, but neither does it deny it."

John married (2) Anne Runyon ^{11,12,13} after 1750. Anne was born about 1719.

NYGBS Record unpublished Additions and Corrections states she was born in 1717 or 1721. Another report identifies Ann Runyon, b. 15 Aug 1705 in Piscataway, Middlesex, NJ, d. Bef Jan 1759 in NJ. According to this latter report, Ann was a twin. After John's death she is probably the Ann Bedell who married in Scotch Plains, Union County, NJ on 20 Aug 1761 William Darby (1692/3-1775) [Newark Evening News, Jun-Sep 1912, "Jersey Genealogies."

Orra Eugene Monnette, *First Settlers of the Plantations of Piscataway and Woodbridge, Olde East NJ, 1664-1714*, part 3, p 629. Ann Runyon, b ca 1771 or 1721 Piscataway, m 1) John Layton, d 1750, m 2) John Bedell. Ann was the daughter of Peter and Providence (Blackford) Runyon of Piscataway.

Fourth Generation

Henry⁴ Bedell ^{1,2,3,4,5,6} [Robert¹, John², John³] was born about 1710.

Henry resided in the Passaic Valley. He later (prior to 19 Aug 1758) moved to Camden County, Georgia [George Chester Bedell's (GCB) *Bedell Family Notes No. 1 (Grandfather of Gale Burwell)*], "but no record has been found there regarding him". Henry's father left in his will to his son John his undivided land in Long Island and New Jersey; to Jacob, the homestead in "Turkie"; and to Henry, "if he returns," a part of his son's bequest [New Jersey Archives, 1st Series, vol 32, p 25].

Littell, *Genealogies of the First Settlers of Passaic Valley*, p 44: Littell erroneously places this Henry as the son of Henry and Mary (Sutton) Bedell; and states [probably correctly] that he moved to the State of Georgia after his marriage to his second wife who was from the southern part of New Jersey. Littell states that he settled and died there.

Burwell states, "Although Littell says that Henry had two sons by his first wife, Sarah C. Bedell in *Family Notes #4* owned by George Chester Bedell says he had 2 sons and 2 daughters by his first wife and only 2 sons by his second wife. Therefore, I have given Catherine to Henry and moved Phebe up to the first wife. Littell says that Henry had 3 children by his second wife, but Sarah C. Bedell in *Family Notes # 4* says that there were only two, both sons.

There is a possibility that this Henry is generationally misplaced. John Spring Bedell, Wesleyan, 1899, Auburn, NY, states that "Henry Bedell and wife 'went west' in 1700 from Hempstead, RI to Littell's Bridge, now in the city of Passaic, NJ. He probably was a grandson of one of the persecuted Presbyterians who fled England during the reign of King Charles the First. John Spring and family left Ipswich, England and settled in Watertown, MA in 1634."

We cannot find a record of a Hempstead, RI, and there is clearly a record of a Henry Bedell moving from Hempstead, Long Island, NY to Littell's Bridge at about this time. The John Spring Bedell *Family Notes* speculate that Henry Bedell had a young son, Robert who was elected "townsman" at Hempstead, Long Island, NY on 17 Mar 1657. Since we have established historical notes of Robert Bedell at Hempstead 10 years earlier than this date, we know that this speculation is incorrect. The John Spring Bedell *Family Notes* state "we knew that he [Henry] married a girl by the name of Sutton before moving [from Hempstead to New Jersey] and so probably had been born before 1680." The John Spring Bedell account clearly had not researched fully all of the available Hempstead town records, particularly the information recorded from that reported by historians as having been contained in the earliest records.

Thus, the author of the John Spring Bedell account makes the assumption that "other Bedells" that appear in the records have been simply assigned to Robert "not knowing where else to place them."

As we know from the town records and Robert's real estate transactions, this assumption by the author is largely without merit. We do not wish to confuse researchers and readers with some of the speculative narrative; e.g., "So far as we know, none of Robert's grandsons were named Henry. Jeremiah had several descendants of that name in New Jersey, one of them founding the Philadelphia Bedell family." Therefore, while we retain the possibility that Henry Bedell is generationally misplaced, we continue to believe that the current placement has a greater possibility of being correct than that offered by the John Spring Bedell Family Notes. We believe that the Grandfather of Gale Burwell, George Chester Bedell, in his Family Notes has greater credibility at this time.

While John Spring Bedell Family Notes suggest that Henry's father may have been an Ezekiel, since at least three of his descendants are named Ezekiel, we prefer the alternate explanation offered. The John Spring Bedell Family Notes state that Ezekiel Mulford was the grandfather of Henry Bedell's daughter-in-law, and that the name Ezekiel may have come from him. The John Spring Bedell account assumes that Henry was born before 1680 based on an undocumented contention that Henry was married to "Miss Sutton" before they moved in 1700 to New Jersey.

At present, we have no documentation on when Henry married Mary Sutton. Clearly, if she was born on 15 Aug 1715, she was not married to Henry in 1700 when Henry supposedly moved to New Jersey. Clearly, there is a problem with the timeline regarding dates of birth, marriage, and the move to Littel's Bridge in the Passaic Valley, New Jersey. However, there is substantial agreement on who Henry married and the names and number of Henry's offspring between Gale Burwell's research (including the George Chester Bedell Family Notes) and the John Spring Bedell Family Notes account. Certainly, there is a much greater confidence, although still assumptive, in the John Spring Bedell Family Notes account of the descendants of Henry. Accordingly, we have quoted much of that account in the notes for the descendants. We begin with his account of Henry and his children.

John Spring Bedell Family Notes: "He [Henry] married a Miss Sutton who was probably the daughter of one of the minor officials of Hempstead. In 1700 they moved to New Jersey and settled at Littel's Bridge -- now in Passaic City. They had 2 children before she died, John and Henry, Jr. The name of his second wife is not known. They had 3 children -- Chester, Jacob and Phebe. I have no further knowledge of Henry, Jr., Chester and Phebe. Jacob had a son named Henry. John and his brother Jacob were still members of the Presbyterian Church at New Providence, NJ in 1768.

"In the same year, 1700, that Henry Bedell left Hempstead, Ezekiel Mulford left East Hampton for New Jersey. He probably was the grandson of John Mulford -- one of the pioneers who helped settle East Hampton in 1649. Ezekiel had a son, Capt. Jonathan who married Esther Conklin -- descended from another East Hampton pioneer. The Captain and Esther had a daughter Deborah who married Henry's son, John."

Bedell Genealogy, Queens Borough Public Library, vol 3, Henry: states Henry married Elizabeth and had children, John and Catherine.

Henry married Mary Sutton^{7,8,9,10} before 1740 in NJ. Mary was born on 15 Aug 1717.

Daughter of John and Elizabeth (Conger) Sutton of Piscataway, Union County, NJ [Burwell, Descendants of John Bedell of New Jersey, vol 1, p 5]. John Sutton was the eldest son of Moses and Jane Sutton of Pepack, Essex [Somerset?] County, NJ, as evidenced in the change in administration of the will of Moses Sutton made 5 Apr 1740. Henry Bedell [Hennery Beegel] is identified in the inventory of the estate, made 7 Jul 1740, as one of the debtors in the estate [Documents Relating to the Colonial History of the State of New Jersey, Calendar of Wills, 1730-1750, vol 2, part 2, p 467].

First Generation

1. **Henry Bedell** ^{1,2,3,4} was born about 1740. He died⁵ in Mar 1798.

Henry resided about 1780 in Sussex, Sussex County, NJ.

On a tax roll [year not identified] he is identified as a single man with no listed property, a certainties value of 2 shillings, a poor tax of 2 shillings, a county tax of 4 shillings and a sinking fund tax of 2 shillings. Henry moved to Sussex, Sussex County, NJ and raised a family. On 15 Jun 1787, in Newtown, Sussex County, NJ, Henry made an inventory of John Sp[r]angenberg's estate on 14 Dec 1784 [Colonial, Revolutionary and Post-Revolutionary History of the State of New Jersey, First Series, vol 35, Calendar of New Jersey Wills, Administration, Etc., vol 6, p 369].

Henry, of Frankford Township, Sussex County dated his will 6 Mar 1798. Inventory of the estate was made 24 Mar 1798, and the will was proved 31 Mar 1798. The will provides to his wife, Susannah, 1/3 of his real and personal property. The estate is to be sold when the children come of age and the proceeds equally divided among them. The children are not named in the body of the will. Executors were his wife Susannah and John and Jonathan Bedell, two of his sons. Witnesses are George Bockoven and John Hough [Colonial, Revolutionary and Post-Revolutionary History of the State of New Jersey, First Series, vol 38 [1944] (Calendar of New Jersey Wills, Administrations, Etc., vol 9, 1796-1800), p 27, Libre 37, p 503].

On 25 Feb 1810, James Bedell and Stephen Sutton [with Joseph Doty] were witnesses to the will of George Bockover [Bockoven] [Colonial, Revolutionary and Post-Revolutionary History of the State of New Jersey, First Series, vol 42 [1949] (Calendar of New Jersey Wills, Administrations, Etc., vol 13, 1814-1817), p 43]. The relationship of James to Henry has not been identified.

Erroneously, Littell, Genealogies of the First Settlers of Passaic Valley, p 44, states that Henry's first wife died and he married again and moved to the State of Georgia. This is not the Henry Bedell who moved to Georgia, and the children attributed to his second marriage are not his children.

Henry married **Susan Sutton** ^{6,7,8,9}.

They had the following children:

On 19 Sep 1808, Henry, now of Hardyston Township, sold to Jesse Gustin of Frankford Township (for \$10) the land that belonged to his father, which Henry had inherited from his sister Susannah, deceased [Sussex County Deed S-310].

On 1 May 1833, he purchased 11.54 acres in Wantage from Ebenezer and Elizabeth Abers [Sussex County Deed N3-485]. Henry Bedell, Jr. of Frankford and his wife, Rebecca Boylan, sold land on 1 Apr 1835 in Frankford to Jacob Roe [Sussex County Deed R3-102]. County, NY [Sussex County Deed S-13]. According to the deed Jonathan lived in Frankford Township. On 13 May 1811, Jonathan Bedell was listed as an account holder in the inventory of the estate of Edward Balding (or Bolding) of Frankford Township, Sussex County [Colonial, Revolutionary and Post-Revolutionary History of the State of New Jersey, First Series, vol 41 [1949] (Calendar of New Jersey Wills, Administrations, Etc., vol 12, 1810-1813), p 18]. On 31 Dec 1816, Jonathan Bedell witnessed the will of George Cymer of Wantage, Sussex County, brother of Peter Cymer, proved 16 Feb 1814 [Colonial, Revolutionary and Post-Revolutionary History of the State of New Jersey, First Series, vol 43 [1949] (Calendar of New Jersey Wills, Administrations, Etc., vol 13, 1814-1817), p 114; vol 42, NJ Post-Revolutionary Documents, Calendar of Wills, 1814-1817, p 114]. Jonathan had at least one child [George C. Bedell, Family Notes #4].

Jonathan became a member of Farmers Lodge No. 14 [Masonic Order], Wantage Twp, Sussex County in 1799 [Newspaper article in Sussex Independent, 10 Oct 1884]. Interestingly, a Jonathan Bedell in 1872 was a charter member and the first Master of Star Lodge No. 709, F. and A. M. [Masonic Order] in Vermillion County [H. W. Beckwith, History of Vermillion County, IL, p 716]. Services were, however, maintained at Dunning's, and later at Bedell's Hall, and continued for a period of fourteen years." The trustees of the church at the time this source was written included H. J. Bedell.
