 the Sundry and Delivery of these Presents well and truly paid by }
 the said Mary Martinangle the Receipt whereof he the said }
 Lancelot well truly acknowledge he the said Lancelot and well }
 and by these Presents well bargained and well sold he the }
 said Mary Martinangle her Heir, Executors Administrators }
 and Assigns All that Plantation Parcel or Tract of Land }
 containing five hundred Acre or thereabouts or more or less being }
 one full Acre or half Part of a certain Tract containing one }
 thousand seven hundred and fifty Acre lying and being on ground }
 commonly called Lancelot Island in the County and Province }
 of South Carolina
