 and heir Engaine. Lord and heir of Sir Robert Engaine. d. 16 Feb. 1357. Sister of Walter de Winton, Bishop of Coventry and Lichfield.
14. Sir Laurence Pakenham <sup>born 1372</sup> married Elizabeth Engaine  
 of Pakenham (sic) d. 10 June 1392. She was dead in 1387.
13. Sir William Cheyney <sup>born 1372</sup> married Katherine Pakenham  
 of Penn Diron. She and her husband, Sir Thomas Huchensley of Millon-Keynes, who was  
 aged 42 in 1403 and d. on 3 Sept. 1408.
12. Sir Laurence Cheyney married Cokayne
11. Sir Frederick Tilney <sup>Knights</sup> married Elizabeth Cheyney
10. Sir Humphrey Bouchier <sup>Dominus Beavers</sup> married Elizabeth Tilney  
 She married Lord Sir Thomas Howard, Kt., Duke of Norfolk  
 and Earl of Surrey. (Half brother of Katherine Howard)
9. John Bouchier <sup>Chancellor of the Exchequer, 6 Henry VIII.</sup> married Katherine Howard  
 Daughter of John, Duke of Norfolk by 2nd wife, Margaret Beaufort
8. Edmund Knyvett <sup>d. 1532</sup> married Janet Bouchier  
 d. 17 February 1561.
7. Francis Bohun <sup>d. 1607</sup> married Elizabeth Knyvett
6. Nicholas Bohun <sup>d. 16 Nov. 1606</sup> married Audrey Coke  
 d. 24 Nov. 1630.
5. Edmund Bohun <sup>d. 16 Nov. 1630</sup> married Dorothy Baxter  
 d. 13 May 1661.

44. Generation Charlemagne married Hildegarde  
number (Continued on the other side) Boonca. 758. of Suabia. died 30 April 783  
King of France; Holy Roman Emperor 800-814; died 28 January 814.
43. Pepin married Beatha  
King of Italy 781-800; King of Lombardy in 781. daughter of William, Count of Toulouse.  
Born in April 773. Died 8 July 810.
42. Bernhard married Comesonde  
King of Italy 813-817; born in 797 and died 17 April 818. who died about 855.  
Blinded and put to death
41. Pepin of Vermandois married \_\_\_\_\_  
Seigneur of St Quentin, Peronne and Solesmes (Solesmes) and died after 844.  
Born in 817/18.
40. Pepin duc de Sens de Valois married \_\_\_\_\_  
Count Berengaricus of Brittany; Count of Bayeux; was living in 833.
39. Pepin II married \_\_\_\_\_  
Count of Sens (Solesmes). (Some records make Pepin II, the brother of Lady Poppa instead of her father)
38. Lady Poppa de Valois married Rollo the Dane  
1st Duke of Normandy. Born in 846; died 931/30.
37. William Longsword married Esprida  
1st Duke of Normandy; Duke of Aquitaine. of Sens, his cousin.  
He was slain by Arnulf of Flanders in 943.
36. Richard I, the Fearless married Lady Gunnora  
3rd Duke of Normandy. Born in 933 and died in 996. of Denmark; who died in 1031.
35. Guillaume married Lesceline  
Compte d'Eu; Comte d'Exmisin (or Hiermois); Lord of Montreuil. de Jurgenville, who died 26 January 1257/58.  
He was the natural son of Richard. She founded the abbey of St Pierre des Dunes.
34. Robert married Beatrice  
Compte d'Eu; Comander the Norman Army at Battle of Mortemer, 1053/54. who died 10 April 1085.  
He founded the Abbey of St. Epreux and died 3 September, about 1093.
33. William married Beatrice de Builly  
Count of Eu; Lord of Hastings. 1st sister of Roger de Builly, Lord of Tickhill.
32. Great grandparent Henry 3rd married Margaret de Champagne from  
Count of Eu; Lord of Hastings; founded Abbey of Foucarmont. who died 15 December 1146. Wm the Conqueror
31. Grandparent John married Alice d'Anjou  
Count of Eu; Lord of Hastings; died 26 June 1170. who died 11 September 1192.
30. Parent Henry married Maud de Warenne from  
Count of Eu; Lord of Hastings; died 16 March 1183. who died in 1210. Charlemagne
29. Alice d'Eu 1131. married Raoul I  
Countess of Eu; Lady of Hastings; died 15 May 1246. de Lusignan; Count of Eu; who died 1 May 1213.  
Daughter of Henry of Eu and Maud de Warenne.
28. Maud d'Eu married Humfrey de Bohun V.  
de Lusignan; died 24 August 1241. 2nd Earl of Hereford; Earl of Essex; born 1200; died 1244.
