My desr Mrs. Calais:-

I am sending you with this pedigree for your Colonial Dames papers, which I believe I was to send you rather than to Lrs. Tiedman.

As you will see, including, I have given you ten or eleven ancestors, all remarkably creditable ones, including three Landgraves and two Governors, but I am very sorry indeed to say I have been obliged to rob you of Col. William Farr of the Ninety Six District.

Your family of Farr's belong to Colleton County, and are descended from one John Farr, a Proprietor's Deputy, who came into the Province before 1685. This is proved by wills and deeds every step in the pedigree.

Thomas John Smith Farr got his name from his maternal grandmother, Phoebe Smith, who was the daughter of one Colonel Smith of Colleton County, and possibly later of Prince William Parish.
