 behalf. On 24 Dec. 1143 he was slain while hunting by an arrow shot at a deer. ②
 The monks of Llanthony + Gloucester disputed for his body + the Bishops of Hereford,
 Worcester + St. David's decided in favor of Llanthony on 28 Dec 1143 where he was
 buried in the chapter house.

He was succeeded by son + heir Roger who hated the Church for his father's
 excommunication. He ^{was} troubled his kinsman, Gilbert Foliot, now Bishop of Hereford, who
 excommunicated him also. He was reconciled to Henry March 1155, dying the same
 year without issue, the shrievalty of Hereford + Gloucester passing to his brother
 Walter on whose death (+ 2 other brothers also without issue) the possessions
 passed to their sisters Bertha who married Abergavenny to Braose + Margaret,
the elder, who took the bulk to the Bohuns, who in 1199 became earls of
Hereford + constables of England.
