

CORBET:

fought at Hastings 1066

I - Hugh Corbet (or Corbeau) living 1040 in Normandy and of ancient lineage; 3 sons:

- ① Hugh, heir in Normandy; ancestor of Corbets of Normandy
- ② Roger (see below)*
- ③ Robert, accompanied his father to England 1066 and had grant of estates in Shropshire; issue:
 - a. Robert, Lord of Alcester, Warwicks, d.s.p.
 - b. Sibil, ancestress of Earls of Pembroke ... Henry I
 - c. Alice, ancestress of Earls of Huntingdon ... Robert "The Consul" Earl Gloucester 1121
- ④ Reginald Fitz Corbet, accompanied Hugh, Count de St. Paul, on crusade 1096; ancestor of Corbets of Artois and Flanders

II - Roger Fitz Corbet had 24 lordships in Shropshire at Domesday; son

III - William de Corbet of Caus Castle and Wattleborough, Shrops 2 sons:

1. Thomas Corbet of Wattleborough, grandfather of:
 - a. Sir Richard Corbet of Moreton, direct forebear of the Baronets Corbet of Moreton, Salop.
2. Sir Robert [ancestor of Peter Corbet of Caus Castle who was summoned to Parliament temp. Edw. I. (extinct)]
 1. Robert Corbet of Caus Castle, accompanied Richard I to seize of Acre.

Clifford (to Badlesmere)

Richard Fitz Ponz, father of Walter de Clifford, temp. Henry II, m. Margaret, d. th Ralph de Toeni by whom he acquired Clifford Castle near Hay, co. Hereford, whence he took his surname. Issue

1. Walter (see below)
 2. Richard, ancestor of Cliffords of Frampton, Co. Gloucester
 3. Rosamund "Fair Rosamund", mistress of Henry II; issue
 → William Longespée, Earl Salisbury (1176-1226) m. Ela Fitz Patrick
 4. Lucia m. Hugh de Say m. Bartholomew de Moretimer
- Walter de Clifford, Sheriff of Herefordshire m. Agnes, d. th Roger de Cundi; he d. 1227 leaving:
1. Walter de Clifford, m. Margaret, dau. of Llewelyn, Prince of Wales, widow of John de Braose; he d. 1263 leaving a dau:
 - a. Maud m. 1244 Sir William de Longespée who + 1257
 m. John, 1st Lord Giffard who + 28 May 1299; she d. 1283 leaving issue:

2. Roger de Clifford m. Sibill, d. + coh. of Robert de Ewyas and widow of Robert, Lord of Tregoz; son:

- a. Roger de Clifford, Justice of King's Forest, Lord of Kingsbury, Warwick; d. 1285; his son:
 1. Roger de Clifford d.v.p. m. Isabel, d. + coh. of Robert de Vipont of Braughan Castle, Westmeath; son
 - a. Robert de Clifford, 1st Lord de Clifford, Sum. Parl. 29 Dec. 1299, m. Maud, d. Thomas de Clare; d. 25 June 1314, leaving 3 sons, ancestors of de Cliffords
