30.	<u>Sanchez IVth</u> King of Castile, (ca. 1134-1158.) 31 Aug.	1151 married	<u>Blanca of Navarre</u> Died 1156, Aug 12 th
29.	<u>Alfonso VIIIth</u> King of Castile, (1155-1214.)	1170 married	<u>Eleanor Plantagenet</u> Born 1161. Daughter of King Henry IInd of England. Died 1214.
28.	<u>Alfonso IXth</u> King of Leon. (1166-1230). Son of Ferdinand IInd, King of Leon, who died in 1188.	1197. married	<u>Berenguela of Castile</u> Daughter of Alfonso VIII and Eleanor. (1171-1246).
27.	<u>Fernando IVth, "the saint"</u> King of Castile, Galicia, Cordova and Leon 1191-1252.	1237 married	<u>Eleanor de Domontain</u> Countess of Pontieu, Montrouil and Aumale. She died in 1273.
26.	<u>Edward Ist.</u> King of England. (1239-1307).	1254. married	<u>Eleanor of Castile</u> Countess of Pontieu. Died 1290, Nov. 27
25.	<u>Humphrey de Bohun, Vth</u> Born 1276. Constable of England. Slain at Broughbridge 16 March 1322. Earl of Hereford and Essex.	1302. married	<u>Elizabeth (Isabel) Plantagenet</u> Born August 1282. Widow of John, Count of Holland. She died 5 May 1358.
24.	<u>Sir William de Bohun, Vth</u> Born ca. 1310/12. Constable of England. Died 16 Sept. 1358. Created Earl of Northampton in 1331.	1355 married	<u>Elizabeth Badlesmere</u> Born 1313. Widow of Sir Edmund Mortimer. Died 8 June 1356. Daughter of Bartholomew de Badlesmere and Margaret Clare.
23.	<u>Sir Humphrey de Bohun, VIth</u> Born ca. 1343. Lord High Constable of England. Died 17 Jan. 1372/73. Earl of Northampton, Hereford and Essex. Lord of Brecknock.	married	<u>Joane Fitz Clare</u> Daughter of Sir Richard Fitz Clare, "Lapped Hat," and Lady Eleanor Plantagenet. Joane departed this life in 1413.
22.	<u>Thomas of Woodstock, Vth</u> Born 7 Jan. 1355/56. 7th son of King Edward IIIrd. Murdered Calais, 1377. Duke of Gloucester; Earl of Buckingham; Constable of England.	after 1374 married	<u>Gloucester de Bohun</u> Youngest daughter and co-heiress of her father. She died 3 October 1392. Her remains rest in Westminster Abbey.
21.	<u>Sir William Bruchier, Vth</u> Earl of Luce in Normandy. He died 8 Henry V. (28 Jan. 1422)	1404 married	<u>Lady Anne Plantagenet</u> Born ca. 1380. She died 17 Henry VII. (8 Oct. 1453)
20.	<u>John Bourchier</u> Lord Berners. He died 16 May 1474.	married	<u>Margery de Berners</u> Daughter of Hugh de Berners, Baron Erreton.
19.	<u>Sir Humphrey Bourchier, VIth</u> Slain at Barnet Field on Easter Day, 14 April 1471.	married	<u>Elizabeth Tilney</u> Daughter of Frederick Tilney of Boston, Esq. Countess of Surrey. She married 1st, Sir Thomas Howard. She died 1 April 1487.
