- 33 Rodrigo Diaz "El Cid" ¹⁰⁷⁴ married Jimena Diaz (ab. ca. 1115).
Born ca. 1043. Señor de Valencia. Died 1099. Daughter of Diego, Conde de Oviedo, and Christina, daughter of fernand Gundemanz by Jimena de Leon.
- 32 Ramiro ^{ca. 1038} married Christina Rodriguez
Señor de Monzon. Daughter of "El Cid" and Jimena.
- 31 Garcia VIIIth ¹¹⁵¹ married Marguerite, dau. of Giselbert, Count of Perche
King of Navarre. Died 1158. 21 Nov. died 1141
- 30 Lancho IIIrd ¹¹⁵¹ married Blanca of Navarre
King of Castile, (ca. 1134-1158). 31 Aug. Died 1156, Aug. 12th
- 29 Alfonso VIIIth ¹¹⁷⁰ married Eleanor Plantagenet
King of Castile, (1155-1214). Born 1161. Daughter of King Henry II of England. Died 1214.
- 28 Alfonso IXth ¹¹³⁷ married Beatrix of Castile ^{8 Nov 1246}
King of Leon, (1168-1230). Daughter of Alfonso VIII and Eleanor. (1171-1246).
Son of Ferdinand IIrd, King of Leon, who died in 1188.
- 27 Fernando IIIrd ¹²³⁷ married Isabelle de Dammartin
King of Castile, Galicia, Cordova and Leon. (1131-1252). Countess of Ponthieu, Montreuil and Comale. She died in 1273.
- 26 Edward Ist ¹²⁵⁴ married Eleanor of Castile
King of England. (1239-1307). Countess of Ponthieu. Died 1238, Nov. 27
- 25 Humphrey de Bohun, VIIIth ^{4 Nov 1302} married Elizabeth (Isabel) Plantagenet
Born 1276. Constable of England. Slain at Boroughbridge 16 March 1322. Earl of Hereford and Essex. Born August 1288. Widow of John, Count of Holland. She died 5 May 1378.
- 24 Sir William de Bohun, K.G. ¹³⁵⁵ married Elizabeth Badlesmere
Born ca. 1310/12. Constable of England. Died 16 Feb. 1388. Created Earl of Northampton in 1357. Born 1313. Widow of Sir Edmund Mortimer. Died 8 June 1356. Daughter of Bartholomew de Badlesmere and Margaret Clare.
- 23 Sir Humphrey de Bohun, IXth K.G. ¹³⁷² married Joane Fitz Alan
Born ca. 1349. Lord High Constable of England. Died 17 Jan. 1372/73. Earl of Northampton, Hereford and Essex. Lord of Brecknock. Daughter of Sir Richard Fitz Alan, "Copped Hat," and Lady Eleanor Plantagenet. Joane departed this life in 1413.
- 22 Thomas of Woodstock, K.G. ^{after 1374} married Alianor de Bohun
Born 7 Jan. 1355/56. 7th son of King Edward IIIrd. Murdered Calais, 1397. Duke of Gloucester; Earl of Buckingham; Constable of England. Youngest daughter and co-heiress of her father. She died 3 October 1393. Her remains rest in Westminster Abbey.
- 21 Sir William Bouchier, K.G. ¹⁴⁰⁴ married Lady Anne Plantagenet
Earl of Essex in Normandy. He died 8 May 1429. (28 Jan 1429). Born ca. 1380. She died 17 May 1416 (10 Oct 1433).
- 20 John Bouchier ¹⁴⁷⁴ married Margery de Berners
Lord Berners. He died 16 May 1474. Daughter of Hugh de Berners, Baron Eresdon.
- 19 Sir Humphrey Bouchier, K.B. ¹⁴⁹⁷ married Elizabeth Tilney
Slain at Barret Field on Easter Day, 14 April 1471. Daughter of Frederick Tilney of Boston, Esq. Countess of Surrey. She married Lord, Sir Thomas Howard. She died 4 April 1497.
