

1. Humphrey de Bohun, kinsman of William the Conqueror with whom he entered England; Lord of Taterford, Norfolk, he died 1113.
2. Humphrey de Bohun II, Magnus, Sheriff of Wiltshire, Baron of the Royal Standard, m. Maud d'Evreux, daughter of Edward d'Evreux, progenitor of the earls of Salisbury; Humphrey founded the priory of Farleigh in Wiltshire.
3. Humphrey de Bohun III, Baron de Bohun, died 6 Apr 1187, buried at Lanthony, Gloucestershire, married Margaret FitzWalter, eldest daughter of Miles FitzWalter of Gloucester, Earl of Hereford & Gloucester, Lord High Constable of England, who married 1121 Sibyl de Neufmarche and died 24 Dec 1143 without male heirs, his younger daughter Bertha, Lady of Brecon & Abergavenny, marrying 1150 William de Braose; Margaret inherited Hereford, died 1146.
4. Humphrey de Bohun IV, died 1182 before his father, having married Margaret, daughter of Henry, Earl of Huntingdon (son of King David of Scotland) and Ada de Warenne.
5. Henry de Bohun (1176-1 June 1220), created Earl of Hereford 28 Apr 1199; in 1200 he accompanied other nobles to summon his uncle, William the Lion of Scotland, to do homage at Lincoln. In 1215 he joined the confederate barons who obtained Magna Carta & was one of 25 appointed surety for same; he died on pilgrimage to the Holy Land; he married Maud (died 27 Aug 1236), daughter of Geoffrey Fitz Piers, Earl of Essex, Sheriff of 9 counties, Justiciar of England 1198, died 2 Oct 1213, married 1184 Beatrice de Say, Countess of Essex, granddaughter of Beatrice de Mandeville who was sister of the 1st Earl of Essex.
6. Humphrey de Bohun V, (1208-24 Sep 1275) Constable of England, Sheriff of Kent, Earl of Hereford, Earl of Essex, Constable of Dover Castle, married Maud de Lusignan (died 24 Aug 1241), Lady of Hastings, daughter of Raoul de Lusignan and his wife Alice, Countess d'Eu in France.
7. Sir Humphrey de Bohun VI, died 27 Oct 1265 during the lifetime of his father; he married Alianore de Braose, daughter of William de Braose of Brechnock, Lord of Abergavenny, and Eve Marshall.
8. Humphrey de Bohun VII, (Sep 1249-31 Dec 1298 at Pleshey), Constable of England, Earl of Hereford, Earl of Essex, married 1275 Maud de Fiennes, daughter of Engerrand, Seigneur de Fiennes in Guisnes, and Maud, daughter of Jacques de Conde.
9. Humphrey de Bohun VIII, (1276-slain at Boroughbridge 16 Mar 1322), married 14 Nov 1302 Princess Elizabeth (Aug 1282-5 May 1316), daughter of King Edward I of England & Queen Eleanor of Castile; he was Earl of Hereford and Essex, Constable of England.
10. Sir William de Bohun, K.G., (1310-16 Sep 1360), Constable of England, Earl of Hereford, Earl of Essex, created Earl of Northampton 1337, married 1335 Elizabeth de Badlesmere (1313-8 June 1356), daughter of Bartholomew de Badlesmere (1275-hanged 14 Apr 1322), Governor of Shipton Castle, Steward of the King's Household, and Margaret de Clare (1286-1365), daughter of Thomas de Clare, Governor of the City of London, and Juliane Fitz Maurice, daughter of Maurice Fitz Maurice, Lord of Offaly, and Emmeline Longspee.
11. Sir Humphrey de Bohun XI, K.G., (1340-17 Jan 1373) Lord High Constable of England, Earl of Hereford, Essex and Northampton, Lord of Brecknock, married Joan Fitz Alan (died 1419), daughter of Richard Fitz Alan (1307-24 Jan 1376), Earl of Arundel, Warrenne & Surrey, Admiral of the West, Judiciar of North Wales, Sheriff of Shropshire, Governor of Carnarvon Castle, & his wife (married 5 Feb 1345), Lady Eleanor Plantagenet (died 11 Jan 1372), daughter of Henry Plantagenet (1281-22 Sep 1345), Earl of Lancaster, and Maud de Chaworth, daughter of Sir Patrick de Chaworth & Isabel Beauchamp.
12. Eleanor de Bohun (died 3 Oct 1399, buried in Westminster Abbey) married 1374 Prince Thomas of Woodstock (7 Jan 1355-murdered at Calais 8 Sep 1397), Duke of Gloucester, Earl of Buckingham, 7th son of King Edward III of England (13 Nov 1312 Windsor-21 June 1377, buried Westminster Abbey), married 24 Jan. 1328 Philippa of Hainault (1312 Belgium-15 Aug 1369 Windsor), daughter of William III d'Avesnes, Count of Hainault & Holland, and Jeanne de Valois.
13. Lady Anne Plantagenet (1380-16 Oct 1438) married 1404 Sir William Bouchier (died 28 Jan 1420), Earl of Eu in Normandy.
