

Page 192 - 'The Chapel of Ease'
stood about 7 miles below Straw
berry Ferry; a Brick edifice in the
form of a Roman cross. After a
few years use it was accidental-
ly burned down - - - amongst
names recorded on the adjacent
tombstones are: - Broughton,

Brown, & Deas. - - - There is
no record of the time when the
chapel was built, something like
the figure - 1721 - appears on the
bell. & from a road bar
we find it was standing in
1725. The oldest inscription
on a tomb there, that is now
legible, is - 1757 - It is that of
Mr. Nathaniel Broughton, of
Newbury Castle, in St. Johns
Parish. Son of Col Thomas
Broughton, who built the castle,
commencing it in 1714; & the
grandson of Governor Nathaniel
De Johnson who died in 1713.

In 1708. Col. Edw. Teyte was made
Governor, but died soon after.
Competition arose as to successor.
One party was for Robert Gilbes,
another for - Thomas Broughton.

Farmer carried the election.
Thinking bribery had been used
to gain the office, a commission
was sent to Charles Gray, a man
of great courage & integrity. His
Council was composed of Thomas
Broughton, (the son in law of Sir
Nathaniel Johnson, who in 1704 -
began to build Mudberry Castle)

Page 154 - (Regarding to surveying of some
land & title to it - (was then grant-
ed by the King) & claimed by Mr. Swin-
ton, of Maryland; & one Mr. Thomas Smith
who states following in his Will -
"died 30 Aug. 1738" - "All of this
was done before Mr. Swinton's sur-
veying title, of which I complain-
ed in Gov. Broughton's time," -

Several hundred acres
of land, returned by virtue of
my patent, by the late Governor
Broughton, when "Surveyor
General", twenty six years ago.
