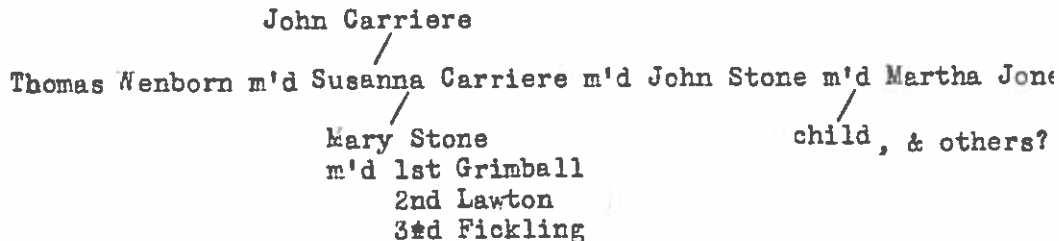
NB - I interpret that Mathurin Boigard had married Susanna, the widow of

The blockmaker is not the John Stone who married Martha Jones and had issue,
and then married Susanna Carriere and had issue. The said blockmaker could
be the son of John Stone and Martha Jones and will possibly prove out to be.

My question still remains merely in reference to John Stone's marriage to
Martha Jones, and if any effort had been put forth in this direction? This
John Stone owns considerable property on POM PON. Susanna Carriere did not
become the wife until after the 24, Oct., 1719, the date of Sarah Linckley's
will, said Sarah having been a wife of Christopher Linckley after one Ann
Grimball, etc.
