On the fly leaf of the Bible is written the name "Thomas Miles Cater 1802". (This was evidently written by him.-G.J.H.)

The date of the printing of the Bible (as printed therein) is "MDCCXCII".

James McPherson Cater, son of Thomas Miles Cater and Catherine Cater was born April 6th 1818 and died November 5, 1824 aged 6 years 6 months and 30 days.

Thomas Miles Cater son of the above was born April 12, 1819 and died October 10, 1824 aged 5 years 5 months and 29 days.

Oh my children I hope we shall soon meet in the arms of Jesus where parting will be no more.

Thomas Miles Cater was born April 12, 1819. My ever to be lamented husband Thomas Miles Cater departed this life January 30, 1819. O my husband thou art only gone to glory.

Thomas Miles Cater was born April 24th 1786 (and died Jany 30th, 1819 aged 32 years 9 mos and 5 days.)

Silas McPherson Cater was born April 2nd 1789.

William Maine Cater was born March 19th 1795 and departed this life September 4th 1796.

In my former communication I mentioned Mrs. Fowke and Miss Rebecca DuPont Cater. Mrs. Fowke was daughter of John James Cater and Miss Rebecca was daughter of Richard Bahun Cater, John James and Richard Bahun being sons of Thomas Miles and Sarah McPherson (Postell) Cater. I believe I had the parentage of the two women reversed before, but the above is correct. My note shows that Miss Rebecca stated to me that the "DuPont" in her name was derived from her great aunt's marriage to Charles DuPont, the great aunt referred to being Susanna Baker Cater, born Aug. 9, 1780, daughter of Thomas and Rachel (Miles) Cater and sister of Thomas Miles Cater. This seems to be a correct statement. The date of the marriage is said to have been Apr. 19, 1804.

I remember very definitely having another note relative to the marriage of a Mary Cater to another Charles DuPont of an earlier generation, whose 2nd wife was a Miss Coachman. I can not locate that note just at this time, but will do so in course of time.-G.J.H.
