The Bible was published by H. C. Carey and J. Lea (Philadelphia) 1823,
which indicates that the first records were not the "original" ones, but

probably copied from an older Bible.

JAMES FURSE was a "mariner" and possibly owned or commanded a vessel plying between Savannah and England which would account for one of his children having been born in Bristol.
