I think you are mistaken as to a Furse marrying a Cater. I never heard of it & have known the Furses all my life. They have lived near the Lower Three Runn always & I was born & raised about 5 miles from them. I have heard my father speak of Uncle Silas Cater of Ala. If there was a Hezekiah it must have been the one in Charleston, I was visiting in Charleston when a girl & was taken for Surie Cater from Ala, who was visiting her uncle, but I don't remember his name. I have heard my father (John James Cater) speak of one of his father's sisters marrying a Dupont, another a Rhoder, also spoke of Aunt Suran Craton & a Jerby, & an Uncle a Rhoder, also lived in Barnwell. The Cratons' & Jerbys lived in James McPherson, who & Duponts in Lower S.C. I have visited the Rhoder at Charlerton, the Rhoder Duponts at Grahamville, S.C. he had one daughter Suran, a son named I Bohun. I think my father's father Charles (they be Suran Portell) married Sarah my father's father (they were born 1845. I don't remember any Provost or Furrer. The Provost must have moved before I was born. I was born 1845. If I can be of any more help write me.
