

Cater Stephen (20-156)

✓ 4 Jan 1785 ltr. of Stephen conveyed to Peter Holbeck 350A 806 acres plantation (Dorchester subdivisions 18-24 formerly mine)

✓ Wm (20-21)

Trustee for Antigua English congregation in 1725 when he was transferred by Richard & wife Sarah Baker.

✓ Thomas (20-25)

m. Susannah Baker dau Richard & Mary (Richard) Baker & sister of Richard Robert Baker, Capt. 2nd Reg. SC troops on Charleston establishment who + 1783 leaving plantation Archdale to son Richard Robert Baker. mansion house of Archdale Hall damaged so badly, by 1886 vertiginous had to be taken down.

1 Mar. 1682 warrant to grant Thos Cater 100 a granted George Lyster (Lyster) Oct. 1677; 23 Mar. 1681 grant 100 a (Proprietary Grants Vol 39 p 45)

(20-28)

Joseph Child 19 Nov. 1750 advertised SC gazette 200 a on Ashley ^{including} ~~plantation~~ 100 a owned by Thos. Cater. + given to Richard & Mary Cater Baker; Jan 1750 John Ainslie m. Miss Mary Child and secured 36 a 20 June 1754 granted Joseph Child; Mary Child Ainslie did and John m. 1762 Lady Mary, widow of Thos. Drayton, dau. of Earl of Cromartie; John & Mary Child Ainslie had one dau, Hannah who m. Jan 1776 Lt. Wm Moncrie, son of Gen. Wm Moncrie; 200 a plant. called "Childs" + later "Bennetts"

(20-32)

✓ 1759 Thos son of Susannah (Baker) Cater received 44 a ($1/10^{th}$) of 443 a. "Chateworth" laid out 31 Jan 1701 to Wm Rowshan whose dau. Susannah m. Wm Baker; Wm Rowshan's will 28 Jan 1715 left ^{the} 400 a. to grandson Josiah Baker whose will left some to heirs of brothers Richard (80) + Elisha (2 children + infants, shows going to 1st cousin Richard Robert Baker who also got share of his elder brother Wm Baker who + young (1746 aged 20) (Property eventually owned by Daniel C. Webb & wife Eliz. Ann Lodson in 1817)

(20-35)

Thos. sold $1/10$ share (44 a.) ^{bought from Wm Hogan} [Sept. 1774 by Benj. Waring] to Wm Hogan (mco Bk B #5 pp 463-466)
