17. JOEL CHANDLER. (John, Joel, JOSEPH, Robert, Robert, John Chandler). Joel, the 8th child of John and Rita, named after his rather famous, grandfather, was born, 1800(50/1850¹, 60/1860²), Greenville, SC. His father, John, was one of four John Chandlers listed in the county that year; he was only there for a few years while he settled the complicated estate of his father, Grandpa Joel Chandler. John, himself, lived to be 94.

Grandson Joel's date of death is contested. Descendants Becky Ramsey and Grace Hairston said he died in 1865; some reports give, 20 July 1876(may be a settlement date); all agree it was due to pneumonia and the place was Little Rock, AR, at the home of his sister,

He was raised in SC, but did not stay long in any one place. He and his family moved to Walton County, GA, by 1819³. Chandler, Reaves and Bonds were next in Carroll County, GA, in 1830, but in Gwinette County, on 5 Oct. 1832. Still restless, he moved to Jacksonville, Benton County, AL, before 6 April 1837, when the newspaper reported Joel Chandler found a stray horse, and he had a letter waiting for him at the post office, 4 Oct. 1838. He picked up some groceries at James M. Mitchell's store and flour mill in Spt. 1838. His mother had died, and Grandpa John, Sr., took up Joel and Rita's invitation to come live with them: John crossed over the border into Piedmont, Benton/Calhoun, AI, by 22 May 1839" because his children now live there !! [Is this a touch of weary irony, he is nearing 90 now?]

Seven years later, Jan. 1844, and 6 years before his father died, Joel was on the move again, sold his land, paid off some notes before his brother, Bailey, died, still looking for good rich farm land. What they found was swampy land and malarial mosquitoes; Joel, packed his family into covered wagons again in the fall of 1845—this time heading west !!!.

"Grandfather, Joel, left Piedmont, Benton, AL, in 1846 with 14 children and 2 slaves and set out" with 7 other families as a wagon train carrying Womacks, Browns, Owens, Sharpes, (each married one of his children) Brewers and Lingos. She was married at 21 and had children for 20 years. Four daughters were married, and Ritta had a babe in arms, when they bid 90-year-old Grandpa John, Sr, "Goodbye" and started the the long, 500-mile trip.

They headed west all the way across AL and MS to the Mississippi River which they crossed on New Year's Day, 1846, and on all the way across AR to the western border to Nathan, Pike County, in the southwest corner of AR, the southeast of OK. (Joel was named in James D. Still's deposition, 31 Jan. 1849, so he had to send an affidavit.)

In 1850 he bought 1000 acres of land, Mine Creek, Hempstead, AR. (a section and a half.) In 1853 his brother, **John, Jr.**, wrote they were fighting the chills and fever and more neighbors were leaving AL. In 1860 he had \$12,000 real estate and \$6474 property. The children expanded into Hempstead and Howard counties.

Joel married, Ritta Bonds, sister of Vardy, daughter of Richard and Mary Tarpley, about 1819, Covington, Newton, GA. Ritta, was born in 1798(52/1850, 62/1860), and was 64 when she was killed⁵ during the Civil War in 1862 in Old Nashville, Howard, AR.

They spent 23 years in GA, but their 25 wedding anniversary was in AL planning a trip, and their 43d anniversary in AR. Joel was probably a sharecropper by all the moving he did, but he must have found AR satisfactory (or Rita set her foot down); they settled down to

spend their next 31 years there. All their boys fought in the Civil War.

Their son, John, was 30 when he was killed at home after the Civil War, 1864, by bushwhackers who wouldn't fight in the War but killed every defenseless man they could find at home. Fearing for Joel's life, his family secretly slipped him out to Little Rock, to the home of his sister, Temperance Camp. Tempy was John's youngest child, who married, Tapley A. Camp in 1825, but was widowed 17 years later, 1842-9; she stayed alone or with her daughter after that. While at Tempy's, Joel contracted pneumonia and died.

Polly's sister, Ritta Chandler Brown, and her daughter, Alveda, were staying with them in 1860(Div? Wid? Husband in Army?).

No doubt they were the Owens family with Joel and Rita in the wagon train to AR.

- ii. Sarah Ann/Sally Ann Chandler. Born, 1822(38/1860², 79/1900³), Walton, GA. She married⁴ her first cousin Daniel Chandler, son of Bailey, 28 Dec. 1843, Benton., AL. He was born, 1825(35/1860). They had 2 children born in Gwinette, GA, when they joined the 1846 wagon train to AR. In 1860⁵ they were at Spring Hill twp, Hempstead, AR; Daniel was working for Thomas Baker while Sarah and all the children were living with her folks in Mine Creek twp. (See last CFAN, p 10) 8 children:

He served in the Civil War, Troop A, AR Cav, CSA. He married, first, in 1846, Matilda Steil. Records not found: may have died in childbirth. He married, second, 3 Oct. 1850, Sarah Ann McVay, Howard, AR,

- who was born, 1823(27/1860); she raised & married off all10 children.





A GOOD NAME

The summer before my Grandparents, Elmer F. and Ethel Chandler, changed their residence to an Eternal one, my wife, Maralyn, and I spent an evening with them.

They were homesteaders in New Mexico where the settlers do not inquire into another's past as many were putting distance between them and adverse circumstances. But this courtesy extended to their neighbors, denied their children knowledge about their heritage.

Elmer and Ethel opened those silent memories and lay them before us. The next morning they went upstairs and brought down large portraits of family, including my Great-great-Grandparents, W.O.B. and Elizabeth Peden, allowing us to make copies with our camera.

This verbal family history sent me to the Library in Little Rock, AR. One of the first books I opened, researching the Chandlers in GA, gave this assessment: "Staunch Presbyterian people; you will find no reproach among their name."

Cousin, Ann Jaget, visited Calhoun, GA, in 2001 to visit the Chandler Cemetery where Great-Great grandfather Abraham Chandler was buried in 1847. Learning of her identity, the news preceded her arrival into the town of Calhoun as if royalty had returned.

A few years ago I was pastoring a church in Wellington, TX. I visited, Herbert Gibbs, also a New Mexico homesteader, who moved to a nursing home there. Ed is a very quiet man— you could easily miss him—but he is a ball of fire when it comes to doing things. Ed loves to fly—he has personally flown a plane over every state in the US and everywhere in the world except over Antarctica and Australia. To do that you have to keep your international shots up to date for the country you are going to set down in. He was a commissioned officer in the Air Force in 1951 at Barksdale Air Force Base, San Antonio, TX, where he taught new pilots to fly. He flew bombers



in the Korean War; was sent to England by the RAF Brontiagthorpe Base 90 miles north of London for an assignment with his son. He was stationed in GA when the Cuban Crisis erupted, becoming indirectly involved. During Viet Nam, he was in S.E. Asia, but sent to Korea at Pueblo crisis.
