In accordance with the terms of the Military Convention, entered into on the twenty-sixth-day of April 1865, between General Joseph E. Johnson, Commanding the Confederate Army, and Major W.T. Sherman, Commanding the United States Army, in North-Carolina, Private J.P. Chaplin, Stuarts Battery, has given his Solemn obligation not to take up arms against the Government of the United States until properly released from this obligation; and is permitted to return to his home, not to be disturbed by the United States authorities so long as he observe this obligation and obey the laws in force where he may reside.

Daughter Ellina (Reynolds) Chaplin, wife of Benjamin Chaplin, Ann Chaplin, their daughter, Daughter Elizabeth Chaplin, Son Thomas Chaplin, William Chaplin, Daughter Sarah Chaplin, Brother John Barnwell Chaplin, "Son Benjamin Chaplin, The factor was widow of William Chaplin, 1st Husband James Reynolds, by whom Daughter Elina, Maiden name Sarah Saxby, of Pon-Pon, thus Benjamin Chaplin her brother-in-law, became her step-son, or son William Chaplin, who married Martha Fripp, is placed only by the will, not being found in Parish Register. John Chaplin was her brother-in-law, John Barnwell, was the husband of her sister-in-law Martha Chaplin.

Sons Benjamin Chaplin, William Chaplin, John Chaplin (under age) wife Ellina, daughter Sarah, Ann. John was a son by his first marriage to <sup>5</sup>Rebe, was probably sent, not being mentioned. Benjamin and Ann are not in Parish Register. This line (2nd wife) is doubly related to line of William Fripp.
