Chaplins are buried in ~~XXXXXX~~ St Helena, Episcopal Church Yard, The epitaphs remains Hilton Head, has been copied and printed in the S.C., Historical & Genealogical magazine of January 1937.

There are a number of Chaplins, buried at WHITE CHURCH, on St Helena, Isl., S.C. the epitaphs were copied and printed in the same magazine January 1934. D

The following is an condensed extract of the will of grand-mother's, brother, also the petition of James Peto Chaplin, and Mary C Chaplin, nee Rhodes, contesting, Robert J. Rhode's, will.

Robert J. Rhodes, of Chatam County, Ga., (Brother of Mary C. Chaplin) he died about September 30-1855, he possessed of considerable personal estate and other property, (without issue) and leaving as his next of kin, John A. Rhodes, of Richmond County, Ga., his father., EXECUTOR.

To my half blood brothers and sisters: Andrew J. Rhodes; Julia Agness Rhodes; John H. Rhodes; Whitney H. Rhodes; Absalom Rhodes; and Seaborn Rhodes, to be divided between my aforementioned brothers and sisters, share and share alike.

I give and bequath to my sister Mary C. Chaplin, nee Rhodes, wife of James P. Chaplin, twenty-five dollars.

It does seem strange that Robert Rhodes, left all of his Estate to his half-brothers and half-sisters, and only \$ 25.00, to his only sister, Mary C. Chaplin, nee Rhodes.
