Sir Henry Peto (2nd Bart., DL & CC Doister, High Sheriff 1896 BA London MA (Trin Call Cobá) born August 10 1840, Son His Father 1889; Married July 16 1874, Mayr, youngesr daughter of Rev Thomas Fuller, vicar of St Peters Eaton Square.

Lineage: William Peto, of Cookham, Burks, Son of James Peto and Mary Bennett, his wife was born July 19 1768, he married October 29 1806 Sophia, daughter of Ralph Alloway, of Dorking and died January 12 1849 leaving issue

(2) William Peto, of Cookham, born Sept 25 1811, married March 3 1840, Emma, daughter of Joseph Hubbs, of Brockmer, and died June 25 1879, leaving issue, by her (who died August 15 1885, age 75 years.

(3) James Peto, of Lowestoft Suffolk, J.P., born December 5 1815, married January 30 1847, Mary (who died May 28 1893) DAUGHTER of John Lawrence of Bisham, Berks and died June 17 1898, leaving issue;

(1) Sophy Peto, she married October 24 1839 the late W. French, of London, and dec.

(2) Ann Peto, Married July 6 1843, the late Edward Bitts, of Preston Hall Kent.

The elder son: Sir Morton Peto, 1st Bart, so created Feb 22 1855, born August 4 1809, married May 18 1831, daughter of Thomas De la Gressell, of Stockwell, Surrey, and by her (who died May 20 1842) had issue.
