CAPTAIN NATHAN M. CLARK - 1826-1869

Captain Nathan M. Clark was a prominent figure in the little City of Champaign [Illinois] in the early days and helped in the making of that city.

The addition to Champaign as noted on the map bears his name and is known as the Farnham, Clark and White's Addition. It covered a large block of lots extending from Washington Street on the north to White Street on the south and from Neil Street on the east to Prairie Street on the west. In the center of the addition is West Side City Park, which was a part of the subdivision and extends over into John P. White's addition. This park was given to the City of Champaign by the platters of said addition.

N. M. Clark also gave to Champaign a smaller addition known as N. M. Clark's Addition extending from White Street to Springfield Avenue and from Lynn Street on the west to Elm Street on the east.

Nathan M. Clark was born in Melford, Connecticut, in August 21, 1826, and died in Rochester, Minnesota, on March 2, 1869, having married Emily L. Burt on November 15, 1853.

He was captain of a company in the regiment of Colonel Samuel T. Busey and served in the Civil War and particularly was with General Sherman on his march from Atlanta to the Sea.

COLONEL JOSEPH CLARK OF TENNESSEE By Charley C. Grigg, Rt. 1, Box 172, Lancaster, TN 35869

Col. Joseph Clarke and wife, Nancy, moved into Tennessee either from Virginia or North Carolina. It is not known at this time where they first settled. My first record of them is in McMinnville, Warren Co., Tennessee, where they settled in the 7th District, at the base of Short Mountain near the beginning of Stones River. The Land Survey of 1827 is the first record I have of them for sure. In 1836, this part of Warren County was cut off and placed in Cannon County. Joseph T. Clarke, their first known child, was on the commission to form Cannon County.

After Col. Joseph Clarke died, his farm was sold and divided among his five children, who may have been the only children living at that time. Old letters written to Joseph T. Clarke mention this division. No record of a will has been found, but the court record of the settlement, by Joseph T. Clarke, shows a balance of \$173.31 and 1/4 cent left after all bills were paid (July 5, 1834, Warren Co., TN, Court Records).

Nancy Clarke is found on the 1850 census of Dekalb County, Tennessee, in Liberty, TN, in the household of her son Joseph T. In 1850, her age was 72 years. She is not found on the 1860 census. Neither Nancy's nor Joseph's burial site has been located.

Col. Joseph Clarke was born ca 1745-50 and died ca 1833-34. Joseph was either married two or three times, making Nancy, mentioned above either his second or third wife. His children by previous marriage(s) follow:

EARLY CLARKS IN HARNETT CO., NORTH CAROLINA Contributed by Nancy M. Grotzinger, 1301 Hamlet Dr., Blue Springs, MO 64014

In 1985, Lt. Col. (USAF Ret.) Victor E. Clark, Jr., of Dallas, Texas, had in his possession the family Bibles of Gilbert Clark and Gilbert's son David. Lt. Col. Clark submitted this information to NCGSJ, where it was first printed.

In addition to the Bible information, some additional information on this family was found in Sketches of North Carolina, by Henry W. Foote, M. G. According to Rev. Foote, Alexander Clark emigrated by 1739 from the Isle of Jura to the upper Cape Fear area of North Carolina. Alexander's father, Gilbert Clark, had a half-brother, Kenneth Clark, whose descendants came to America some time later. Alexander had eight children, of whom four sons are given by Lt. Col. Clark: Gilbert (of whom later), John, Daniel, and Archibald).

V-D JAMES ARTHUR CLARK

James Arthur Clark, youngest son of James Towles Clark and Mary Ann Wiltshire was born 10 Sep 1853 in Unionville, VA, and died 22 Jan 1903 in Fredericksburg, VA. He married 11 Nov 1880 Emma Frances Britton, who was born 8 Nov 1861 and died 18 Jun 1944. Both are buried in Rhoadesville Baptist Church Cemetery. James Arthur and Emma B. Clark inherited the "Old Home Place" (Watt Gambrel property) from James Towles Clark and provided a home for James Arthur's parents until their death. After James Towles died in 1893, James Arthur and Emma moved in Oct 1894 to "Oak Hill" and sold the "Old Home Place" to their nephew, William Henry Hossley. On 6 Sep 1900, they sold "Oak Hill" to Monroe and Melzie Waugh and moved to Fredericksburg, VA, where they resided until their deaths. James Arthur and Emma Clark had 10 children:
