JAMES DANIEL

In the Name of God amen I James Daniel, of the County of Orange planter being in perfect health of Body and of perfect mind and memory Thanks be given unto God Calling unto mind the mortality of my Body knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say, principally and first of all, I Give and Recommend - my soul into the hand of Almighty God, that Gave it, and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian Burial, at the Discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall Receive the same again, by the mighty power of God, and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God, to Bless me in this life with, I Give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form Item I Give and bequeath to Ann Daniel my dearly beloved wife whom I likewise Constitue make and ordain the sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament all my lands and all my Slaves together with all my stock of horses Cattle hogs sheep and Goats also all my household and Kitchen furniture and all and singular my whole Estate what I am possessed of now both Real and personal and all that I shall or may be possessed of at my decease together with all debts or sums of money that is due to me or that shall become due to me hereafter and Remain unpaid untill my decease whether it be by Bond promissary note mortgage Book account or otherwise by her freely to be possessed and Enjoyed during the term of her natural life, and at her decease to dispose of as she shall see Cause, and I do hereby utterly disallow Revoke and disannull all and Every other former will or Testament Ratifying and Confirming this and as other to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Eleventh Day of September - In the year of our lord one thousand Eight hundred and four and in the twentyninth year of the Independence of America signed sealed published pronounced and declared by the said James Daniel as his last will and
