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DEWITT.

The DeWitt family is one of the very ancient families of Holland. "The Geschlachten Von Dordrecht" in the Royal Library in the Hague in Holland, gives a history of the family in an unbroken line for over three centuries from the year 1295 to September 8, 1639. John DeWitt Sr., the common ancestor of the family in America, was a Burgomaster in the City of Dort in 1600. He was entrusted with diplomatic business by the States-General which he discharged much to his credit, and greatly to the satisfaction of the Assembly. But his zeal did not save him from a close imprisonment in the Castle of Louvestien, the common receptacle of state criminals who refused to obey the arbitrary edicts of a tyrant. His son, John DeWitt Jr., was born in the City of Dort, September 25, 1625. He indicated, says an old writer, "precocious signs of that extraordinary genius which burst forth in a blaze of glory at its meridian but was doomed to go down in a sea of

blood. His teachers complained that he knew more than they, and they proposed him as a model for all youthful aspirants. He early developed a strong passion for the law and the mathematics. But his ruling passion was for the control of public affairs. He was highly accomplished in what was then called the seven liberal arts. After finishing his academical course at the University of Leyden, and taking his degree as Doctor of Laws, he traveled into foreign countries. On his return he was created Counselor Pensionary of his native city. He was then twenty-five years old. He was soon after elected Grand Pensionary of Holland and West Friesland. To crown his happiness he espoused a lovely damsel, Miss Wendela Bikker, a granddaughter of a Burgomaster of the City of Amsterdam.

Holland was at that time in war with England whose forces were led by Oliver Cromwell. The latter was a great hater of the house of Orange, and the young Prince of Orange was under the especial care of John DeWitt. A great naval battle between the Dutch fleet of forty vessels commanded by Admiral Van Tromp and Vice Admirals DeRutger, Dewitt and Evertzen, and the English fleet of twenty vessels commanded by Admiral Blake, was won by the Dutch. This was hailed with great rejoicing by the Dutch, but the next year, another great battle was fought between the fleets in which VonTromp was killed and the Dutch defeated. This led to a treaty of peace, in the making of which Cromwell insisted that Holland should unite with Great Britain and send deputies to a general parliament similar to the United Provinces. But the Dutch ambassadors resisted the attempt and concluded

a treaty which kept Holland under its own form of government. Some of the provinces alleged that DeWitt was concerned in this attempt against his own country, and resided a storm of tumult against him. This he quieted. In 1657 Holland was racked by a civil war, which he was chiefly instrumental in quieting. He was feted by the chief dignitaries of Europe, and throughout the troublous times that followed between his country and England and lastly with France he was a great power. In 1671 England and France combined efforts against Holland. Then reverses followed for the States-General. The people became disaffected and accused some of their leading men with betraying Holland to the enemy. Insurrections arose in many cities. DeWitt, being accused, offered to resign. His resignation was accepted. Cornelius DeWitt, a brother of John's, was charged by a scoundrel with suborning him to assassinate the Prince of Orange. The wrath of the populace was aroused to fever heat by the lies and rumors of his that were bandied about concerning the DeWitt brothers. Cornelius was tried and though not found guilty, was sentenced to banishment. The people were disappointed that he was not executed. A committee was sent to get John to visit his brother at the prison. He went there. He was struck down by the butt-end of a musket. His brother was dragged from the prison and both were hanged. Crazy with vengeance, the mob tore their hearts from their bodies and threw them in their faces. Thus perished two of the master minds of Holland.

The old historian says: "Under the chancel of the old Protestant Church at the Hague, their bodies rest in hope, awaiting the resurrec-

tion of the just, but their memory will be embalmed in the hearts of virtue and valor are honored among The epitah to John DeWitt:

"Here lie the remains of a man of universal genius, the professional statesman and the most adroit diplomat of his age in war as well as in peace; the prop of the Republic of which even his enemies regarded him as the surest oracle. He was laborious, indefatigable, vigilant, sober and modest, always serious, but easy, affable and agreeable. As disinterested as a man could be, proposing to himself no other object but the good of his country and the establishment of her liberties. Although he was civil to all men, by employing the base arts of a demagogue. Always equal to himself, and undisturbed in the midst of the greatest calamities, his mind never lost its equanimity and to the last sigh of his life he exhibited by heroic fortitude a memorable example of what a man is capable of, whose conscience reproaches him nothing."

He left various writings, among which his treatise on life annuities was the beginning of life insurance.

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DEWITT.

(continued from last week)

Tjereck Claessen DeWitt, an alder brother of the Grand Pensioner before mentioned, came to America about 1639. His birthplace has been fixed at Grootholt, Sunderland, in Holland, which was in the vicinity of Dort. In 1648 he, with his son, Andries, purchased lands in the then new settlement called Wildwyck, now Kingston, Ulster County, N. Y. His other sons were: Tjereck Jr., Jan, Jacob, Lucas, Peek and daughters, Tjaatje, Janetje, Gertrung, Rachel, Maretje and Angillie.

In 1683, the Indians made an attack on Wildwyck. They were mostly from the up river tribes, although a number of warriors from the Mianal tribe were with them from near Minisink Island. The account of this attack is preserved in New York State documents, and was signed by Tjereck Claessen DeWitt among some others. It is as follows:

"To the Council of New Netherlands:—

Right, Honorable, most respected,

wise, prudent & a very discreet Lords. We, your honor's faithful subjects have to report, pursuant to the order of the Rt. Hon'ble Hear Director General in the form of a Journal, that in obedience to His honor's order, received on the 30th of May last, we caused the Indian sachmens to be notified on the 6th of June, to be prepared to expect the arrival of the Rt. Hon'ble Director General, to receive the promised presents, and to renew the peace. This notification was communicated to them through Capt. Thomas Chambers, to which they answered, "If peace were to be renewed with them, the Hon. Hear Director should with some unarmed persons sit with them in the open field, without the gate, as it was their own custom to meet unarmed when renewing peace or in other negotiations."

But they, unmindful of the preceding statement, surprised and attacked us between the hours of 11 and 12 o'clock in the forenoon of Thursday, the 7th inst. Entering in bands through all the gates, they divided and scattered themselves among all the houses and dwellings in a friendly manner, having with them a little maize and some few beans to sell to our inhabitants, by which means they kept them within their houses, and thus went from place to place as spies to discover the strength of our men. And after they had been about a short quarter of an hour within this place, some people on horseback rushed through the mill gate from the new village crying out, "The Indians have destroyed the new village," and with these words the Indians here in this village immediately fired a shot and made a general attack on our village from the rear, murdering our people

in their houses with their axes and their tomahawks, and firing on them with guns and pistols; they seized whatever women and children they could catch and carried them prisoners outside the gates, plundered the houses and set the village on fire to windward, it blowing at the time from the south. The remaining Indians commanded all the streets, firing from the corner houses and through the curtains outside along the highways, so that some of our inhabitants, on their way to their houses to get arms, were wounded and slain. When the flames were at their height the wind changed to the west, were it not for which the first would have been much more destructive. So silently and rapidly did murder do his work that those in different parts of the village were not aware of it until those who had been wounded happened to meet each other, in which way the most of the others also had been warned.

The greater portion of our men were away at their field labors, and but few in the village. Near the mill gate were Albert Gysberten, with two servants, and Tjereck Claessen DeWitt; at the sheriff's, himself with two carpenters, two clerks and one thrasher; at Cornelius Barceisen Sleght's, himself and his son; at the dominie's, himself, two carpenters and one laboring man; at the guard house a few soldiers; at the gate towards the river, Henderiek Jochemson was severely wounded in his house by two shots at an early hour. By these aforesaid men, most of whom had neither guns or side arms, were the Indians, through God's mercy, chased and put to flight on the alarm being given by the Sheriff. Captain Thomas Chambers, who was wounded on coming in from without, issued immediate orders (with the

Sheriff and commissioners) to secure the gates; to clear the gun and drive out the savages, who were still about half an hour in the village, aiming at their persons, which was accordingly done. The burning of the houses, the murder and carrying off woman and children is here omitted, as these have already been communicated to your Honor's on the 10th of June. After these few men had been collected against the barbarians, by degrees the others arrived, who it has been stated were abroad in their field labors, and we found ourselves when mustered in the evening, including those from the new village who took refuge amongst us, in number 69 efficient men, both qualified and unqualified. The burnt pallades were immediately replaced by new ones, and the people distributed during the night along the bastions and curtains to keep watch. On the 10th inst. ten horsemen were commanded to ride down to the Redoubt and to examine its condition. They returned with word that the soldiers at the redoubt had not seen any Indians. They also brought with them the sergeant who had gone the preceding morning to the redoubt, and as he heard on his return of the mischief committed by the Indians in the village, he went back to the redoubt and staid there. In addition to the sergeant they brought back the men who had fled from the new village.

On the 16th, towards evening, Sergeant Christian Nicassen went with a troop of soldiers, sent us by your Honors, being 42 men and three wagons, to the Redoubt, with letters for the Mannhattans, addressed to your Honors, and to bring up ammunition from the Redoubt. On their return the Indians made an attempt,

at the first hill, to take the position from these troops. The sergeant, having divided his men in separate bodies, evinced great courage against the Indians, skirmishing with them from the first, to past the second hill, and defending the wagons so well that they arrived in safety in the village. He had, however, one killed and six wounded. The dead man was brought in the next morning, having been stripped naked, and having had his right hand cut off by the Indians. Some of the Indians were also killed, but the number of these is not known. This skirmishing having been heard in the village, a reinforcement of horse and foot was immediately ordered out, but before they arrived the Indians had been put to flight by the above named Sergeant.

This Rt. Hon'ble Lords is what we deem necessary to communicate to you in the form of a Journal as to how and in what manner the Indians have acted toward us, and we towards them in the preceding circumstances. And we humbly and respectfully request your honors to be pleased to send us hither for the wounded by the earliest opportunity some prunes and linen, with some wine to strengthen them, and whatever else not obtainable here, your honors may think proper; also carabines, cutlasses and gun flints, and we request that the carabines may be Snaphaunce, as the people here are but little conversant with the use of the Arquebuse (ryer roet); also some spurs for the horsemen. In addition to this, also, some reinforcements in men inasmuch as harvest will commence in about 14 days from date.

Herewith ending, we commend your Honors to God's fatherly care and

In a letter received from H. A. VanFredenberg, of Sparrowbush, N. Y., he says, concerning the sketch of the DeWitt family, which has been appearing in the Recorder for the past three weeks, that his mother was a DeWitt, a daughter of Aaron DeWitt, who formerly lived in Wantage and removed to Montrose, Pa., when she (his mother) was a young girl. Grand-uncles of Mr. VanFredenberg who lived around Deckertown were Jacob, Levi (or Evi) and others long since passed away.

We quote further from Mr. VanFredenberg's letter:

Have you the records of the VanVredenberg family, cotemporary with Cornelis and Jan DeWitt? Both the families opposed the Orange royal family, and both families sent emigrants to Niemo Amsterdam. The present VanVredenberg, who occupies the old Castle Vredenberg mentioned in Motley's history of "The Dutch Republic," seems to have abated his long-time hostility to the Orange family, as he now bears the title of "Baron." He came here to participate in the Hudson-Fulton celebration ten or so years ago. You will find his name in the State report of that celebration as Barcn VanVredenbergh. So far as I have ever known the family name was "Vredenberg" ever since 1200 or 1300. Why he adds the "h" I do not know, as the old name was compounded of two brief, simple names: Vreden—peace, and Berg—hill and the word translates as Peacehill, or Contentineal hill, or a dozen other ways, all meaning exactly the one thing, hill or mound or mount of peace.

The Vredenberg Castle had its own little hill or tee, or mound. When it was built, before the dykes were begun, it was each year submerged when the Fall's northwest winds pushed the sea so high that much of the Castle made a mound of the dirt or sand several feet high, and on the mound built the foundation for the structure. The dykes afterward held the sea back. Can you tell me whether there are "Coats of Arms" for the DeWitt's and VanVredenberg's? As they opposed royalty and aristocracy, it would seem to be logical for them to care nothing for titles, although both families were high enough in social rank to parade "Coats of Arms."
