He was making the move, since his & his wife's folks are there in Oklahoma City, the better paying job is the reason.

does Francis still live there. Her & Bob are cousins, but strangers.

Haven't heard from Jim & Myrtle since I was down there in May. They had just heard from Howard. He told them the bad news His Dr told him, they pronounced His illness "Lukemia"

He was still on his job. He's retired from the Army, but is employed in recruiting office, (Civil Service)

lives in St. Louis, Mo. Grace has moved to Siloam Springs, Ark. That's west of Fayetteville, near the Okla border. She said she had much rather live in Ft. Smith, but she was getting a job she liked much better. That's what she told them, I hope she is happy with it.

park in the Center. all of the square
was demolished, we pay our taxes
there, as we are in that Dist.
