7 July 1779

- p. 31 John L. DeWitt served as Petit Juror 8 June - 27 Sep 1779
- p. 34 John L. DeWitt wit. for John Volkersburg 8 July 1779
- p. 36 Henry DeWitt indicted 22 Dec 1780 for receiving Scienter stolen silverware {6 table-
spoons, 12 teaspoons, a skimmer & 2 tea tongs}, 26 Dec pleaded not guilty.
Andriea DeWitt was his attorney at trial 28 Dec. 1780.
John DeWitt & Andriea DeWitt wit. for defendant. He was acquitted.
