Charles DeWitt served as Grand Juror in Elyon Co in 1809 and 1810

Charles DeWitt had prize & blank in 1805 Ga. (Elyon Co.) Lottery

Charles DeWitt, Jr. administrator of John C. Howell dec'd Feb 20, 1821

Chas DeWitt, Jr. adm. of James Burnett (his brother-in-law & my gg grandfather) gives notice to debtors & creditors of deceased Mar. 10, 1821.

Brunswick Elyon Co. Court House Vol 1 minutes: page 42 It is ordered that the real & personal property of said estate of John Holland be divided by James May, John L. DeWitt & Daniel Lubion Mar. 1826

page 35. petition of Chas. DeWitt Administrator of estate of Charles DeWitt, Sr. deceased for leave to sell the real estate of said Charles DeWitt & it having appeared that legal advertisement has made it his intention to make said application to this court. It is ordered that said petition be granted.

page 28-29. (Jan 5, 1824) A petition of James May, Chas DeWitt, Joseph Bennett in right of his wife Ellen John L. DeWitt heirs of Chas. DeWitt late of this County. It is ordered that the personal property of said estate of Chas DeWitt be divided by John Burnett Jr. John Harris & James Moore. Among the heirs of said estate. The parties concerned being served with a copy of this

order within 20 days before a decision shall take place.

The 1850 Bibb County (Ga.) census says that Ellen was born in Ga. and she was approx 50 yrs old that is the reason I believe that Charles DeWitt came to Ga prior to 1800 - also her mother was in the household then so she should have been sure where she was born.

Oglethorpe Co, Ga. Minutes, March 7, 1842 Rebecca Rumph was appointed admr. of Jacob Rumph. James M. Bryan was appointed Admr. of the business of John F. May estate.

June 12, 1843. John M. Smith was appointed temporary Admr. of Jacob Rumph, deceased, Mrs. Rebecca Rumph heretofore appointed having failed to give bond as Admr.

July 3, 1843: Rebecca Rumph qualified as Admr. of Jacob Rumph. James C. Mangham was appointed guardian of John D. and Mary Rumph, minors, over age of 14 years each, and of George D. Rumph under the age of 14.

Sept. 4, 1843: In re, Jacob Rumph estate, leave to sell was granted.
