Know all men by these presents that we James De Witt Senr. and John Milhous Senr. both of Edisto River in said State have entered into copartnership to Build and erect Mills on Sand purchased from Daniel Boyley on Castle Creek for that purpose to commence on or before the first day of January next ensuing the date hereof, and to continue for and during the term of twenty-one years from the commencement, and the said parties by these presents do covenant and agree to and with each other their heirs and assigns, that they will furnish what assistance they can in everything requisite for Building and Compleating said intended Mills and the said James De Witt and Sarah his wife their heirs and assigns giveth and alloweth said concern the privilege of knowing the soil grounds of the Creek on their Sands and for what Timber the Mills shall make use of growing on the said Sands for which privilege during said term the sd James De Witt his heirs and assigns shall be allowed the sum of fifty pounds sterling and the said parties shall be equal in all expences and profits which may accrue by the Building and carrying on said Mills and for the purchase of said land, or any other which may be thought necessary for " concern, and each party shall furnish three good hands who shall be constant at said concern during said term + each party shall furnish what additional hands they can spare from time to time for which they shall be allowed the sum of one shilling and six pence for day for field hands + each party shall furnish their own hands with provisions and accomodations and the said John Milhous etc.
