Hon. Charles Henry DuPont, Chief Justice of Supreme Court of Fla. 1860 -
Born Branford Dist, Sc 27 Jan 1805 (see Fla. Reports Vol 6-12)

Grad. Franklin College, Ga. 1826

Settled Gadsden Co., Fla. 1827, bought plantation, practiced law & planted; built mansion in Quincy, sold in 1875

Died at residence of son-in-law Capt. William B. Malone, Quincy, Gadsden Co., Fla.
14 Oct. 1877

Lost his father at an early age; his mother sent him to Ohio to be educated by working on a farm & going to school.

Judge of Gadsden Co. Court, Representative & Senator, General 1836 in Indian uprising. Returned to private life; bank failure left him penniless. Elected Assoc. Justice of State Supreme Court 1854. Organized Agricultural Society - Methodist Episcopal Ch. member
