Anna Margaret, dan. of Peter & Katharine Durr, born 20 Jan 1758, was bapt. Sat. 4 Nov. 1758 at the House of John Aberly below Orangeburgh Twp. (p. 180)

Sun. 3 Feb. 1751 Eva Maria, dan. of Werner & Anna Maria Ulmer, born 28 Dec 1750, Sponsors: Hans George Shuler Sr., Anna Maria, wife of John Schaumlöffel, & Esther Ott. (p. 127)

Tues. 26 Dec 1752 John Schaumlöffel present at wedding of Christophor Monheim to Catherine Fry (p. 115)

Tues. 3 Mar 1759 present at baptism of Anna Margaret, dan. of Jacob & Eva Catharine Stromann, born 3 Nov. 1758, at home of Jacob in Orangeburgh Twp. (p. 183)
