

WARRANTS FOR LANDS IN SOUTH CAROLINA

1692 - 1711

John Bird had a special warrant for fifty-five acres of land in Berkley County, being land formerly granted to Anthony Chune in a greater tract and descended by Sev's means conveyance to Jn. Tothill and Escheated Dated August the seventh 1702.
