David Ellis most likely the first Ellis to set foot on American soil. He arrived at Jamestown

June 7, 1610. About three years after Jamestown was settled May 14, 1607. His son John Ellis settled in Northampton County, Va. John Ellis Jr married a girl named Susannah and their children were John, William (1705 ^{May} 1788), Thomas, Henry, James, Joseph (1713) Mary, and Charles (1719 1759)

William had children as follows; John, William Jr., Jacob, David, Susannah, Lucy, Elizabeth, and Mary.

William Ellis Jr. (B - Sept 12, 1923) married a — — Walker. He was the father of Gilbert Ellis Sr (1777-1838) who was a native of North Carolina and moved to Bullock County, Ga. Miles Ellis Sr married Elizabeth Hagan, and had ten children being named in order of birth as follows, Polly, Sara, Elizabeth, Martha Mary, Frances, John, Gilbert, Colson, and Thomas C.

Miles Ellis Sr (1777-1838) and family moved from Georgia to Fla in 1820 and settled in Nassau County. Miles Ellis Sr and family next moved to Hoytown (Gainesville) Alachua County, Fla, on December 24, 1824

From Jamestown, June 7, 1610, the line of descent is as follows. David Ellis, his son John Ellis, his son John Ellis Jr, his son Charles Ellis, his son William Ellis and his son Gilbert Ellis Sr to Hoytown (Gainesville) Dec 24, 1824 - 219 yrs + 6 mo and 17 days!

THE ELLIS FAMILY

GILES ELLIS
1777-1838

Giles Ellis, a native of North Carolina, was born in 1777 and died April 21, 1838. He married Elizabeth Hagan. He was a son of William Ellis of English extraction. Giles and Elizabeth had ten children being named in order of birth as follows: Polly, Sara, Elizabeth, Martha, Macy, Frances, John, Giles U., Colson, and Thomas C. The family moved from Georgia to Florida in 1820 and first settled in Nasseau County. They next moved to Alachua County on December 24, 1824. Elizabeth married "Orphra" Weeks and their son "Bill" Weeks was for many years the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Bradford County, Florida.

JOHN ELLIS
18__-1833

John, son of Giles and Elizabeth, and his wife, Martha, were the parents of John H. Ellis, Jr., who was born February 12, 1833. John Ellis, Sr., was killed by a horse in Alachua County on February 22, or 27, 1833, about two weeks after the birth of John Jr.

CAPT. THOMAS C. ELLIS
1814-__

Capt. Thomas C. Ellis, the youngest son of Giles and Elizabeth Ellis, was born in Bullock County, Georgia, September 30, 1814, and died _____. He was taken to Florida at the age of six years. The family settled in Nasseau County in 1820. On December 24, 1824, he was removed to Alachua County where he was reared and was always engaged in farming and stock raising. On December 18, 1839, he married Sarah A. Townsend of Liberty County, Georgia, who was born in 1820, a daughter of Light and Phoebe (Carter) Townsend. To this union were borned thirteen children. Six of whom were living in 1889 and named as follows: Thomas B., William B., George R., Louis C., Pauline (wife of Frank McIlvane) and Margerette E., (wife of Robert McClellan). He was made Captain and rendered distinguished service in the Indian war in Florida in 1835 to 1842. He was Sheriff in Alachua County in 1842. For many years before his death he was one of the leading citizens of Gainesville and Alachua County and was held in high esteem by all who knew him.

THOMAS B. ELLIS

1842-_____

Thomas B. Ellis, oldest son of Capt. and Sarah Ellis, was born in Alachua County on June 2, 1842, and was educated in the common schools of his day. In 1861 at the outbreak of the Civil War he answered the call to arms of the Confederacy and enlisted in the Third Florida Volunteers, in a Company commanded by Capt. W. C. Saxon. He served principally in Florida, Mississippi, Tennessee and Kentucky; he was wounded in the battle of Perryville, captured and taken to Louisville, Kentucky, where he was held a prisoner one month and then sent to Vicksburg, Miss., for exchange. He later rejoined his command and served faithfully to the end of the Civil War between the states. After several business ventures most of them successful, he settled in Gainesville, Florida, and under the firm name of McClellan and Ellis entered the general merchantile business dealing mostly in hardware, furniture, mill supplies, etc.

In 1878 Thomas B. Ellis married Dora Cattrell of Florida, a daughter of Hon. J. L. F. Cattrell, and this marriage was blessed by the birth of four children: Thomas B., Jr., Allie, Mag, Dorean C., and Charles R. Thomas B. Ellis was a Master Mason, a consistent member of the Baptist Church and an outstanding citizen of Alachua County.

MAJOR GILES UNDERHILL ELLIS

1809-1886

Giles U. Ellis, the son of Giles and Elizabeth Ellis, was born March 22, 1809, in Dooley County, Georgia. He came to Florida as a boy in 1820, when the Ellis family settled in Nasseau County. This family moved to Alachua County in 1824. On April 22, 1830, Giles U. Ellis married Mary Branning of Green Cove Springs, who was born of Andrew Branning and Susan, his wife, October 1, 1815. Mary was a sister of the Rev. Levy Branning. This union was blessed with the following children: Solomon H. Ellis, born January 28, 1831, and died December 18, 1851, nearly twenty-one years old; George B. Ellis was born June 5, 1833, and married _____, and died _____; Elizabeth S. Ellis was born October 26, 1837, married Robert Martin, and died _____; Easter Florida Ellis was born May 30, 1840, married Joel Keathley Niblack, and died _____; Catherwood Ellis was born May 11, 1843, and was killed the day before the battle of Olustee February 20, 1864, while riding a white horse in "Hart's Lane"; Texas Ellis was born March 22, 1845, married John F. Niblack, and died _____; California Ellis was born August 2, 1848, married William H. L. Townsend, and died _____; Frances Utah Ellis was born August 5, 1850, married John J. Bunch, and died December 20, 1898; Mary Giles Ellis was born February 15, 1853, and died September 11, 1857, about four and a half years of age. Mary Branning Ellis,

the first wife of Giles U. Ellis, died September 12, 1855. Giles U. Ellis married Nancy L. (Jones) Townsend, a widow of the late W. C. Townsend on March 27, 1856. Nancy, at the time she married Giles U. Ellis, had five children of the late W. C. Townsend. Their names and marriages are as follows: William H./L. Townsend and California Ellis, Levonia Townsend and James Stanley, Evelena Townsend and T. C. Carroll, Malvina Townsend and Charlie Martin, and Nora Townsend and Dr. Calhoun Hunter.

Giles U. Ellis and his wife, Nancy, had two children, Mattie Buchanan Ellis, who was born March 24, 1857, married Milton Densler, and died _____; and Thomas Brag Ellis, who was born June 24, 1863, and died _____. Nancy L. Townsend Ellis died March 12, 1886, and Giles U. Ellis died eight days later, March 20, 1886.

When Giles U. Ellis moved from Alachua County to Columbia County, he first lived in a double--pen log house where the late "Bob" Martin later lived. Afterwards he moved to Mikesville where he lived in a double-pen log house until he died in 1886.

It is believed that Giles U. Ellis and his first wife, Mary Branning, lived near Gainesville where Mary Branning died, September 11, 1857, and was buried near the old Ellis home, not far from Gainesville.

Giles U. Ellis was a Captain in the Indian War in 1835-1842 in Florida and was in charge of the defense of a large portion of Columbia and Alachua Counties in that War; and built the following Forts: Tustennuggee, Fort Call, Mt. Tabor, and rebuilt old Fort White, Fort Newnansville, and perhaps Fort Fannin on the Suwannee River.

Giles U. Ellis served as County Commissioner of Columbia County in 1847 and 1862. His commissions were dated October 22, 1847, and January 22, 1862, respectively. He served as Representative from Columbia County for two sessions 1845 and one session in 1848 in the first General Assembly, (Legislature), of Florida, after its admission to the Union, March 3, 1845.

During the Indian Uprising in 1856-1857 he was made a Major and defended about the same territory against the Indians.

The tax roll of Columbia County for 1849 shows the property of Giles U. Ellis as follows: 26 slaves, 474 acres of land, \$1200.00 loaned on interest, 1 watch, 75 vehicles and carriages, 200 head of cattle, and his taxes were on that property \$22.80.

The tax roll of Columbia County for 1850 shows the property for Giles U. Ellis was as follows: 29 slaves, 510 acres of land, \$1892.00 loaned on interest, 1 watch, 75 vehicles and carriages, 200 head of cattle, and his taxes on that property were \$24.91.

Giles U. Ellis before the Civil War ran and operated a store of

general merchandise at Ellisville, which was named in his honor. His slave "quarters", dwelling houses for his slaves, were between the present "Churchwell" house and the paved highway in the field which he cleared with his slaves in 1856. He bought off of the Slave Block in Charleston, S. C., for \$1000.00 in gold a negro male slave, about twenty years of age--Ben McNish, who became the ancestor of the McNish family of colored people in Columbia County. At the Surrender, at the close of the Civil War in 1865, he freed 63 slaves.

He was a leading political figure in Columbia County for more than a quarter of a century and a consistent member of the Baptist Church.
