JOHN A.⁹ Sibley attended a preparatory course at the Georgia Military College before entering the University of Georgia. He graduated with an LL.B. in 1911 and received his LL.D. at Oglethorpe University in 1950 and at Mercer University in 1952. He was admitted to the Georgia Bar in 1911 and began his practice of law at Milledgeville, Ga., with the firm of Sibley and Sibley. He later joined the firm of King and Spalding at Atlanta and from 1918 to 1946 was with Spalding, Sibley and Troutman. He was a judge of the County Court of Baldwin County, Ga., from 1914 to 1918. He was a director and became chairman of the executive committee of the Trust Company of Georgia, and he was a director of the Georgia Power Company, the Retail Credit Company, the Coca Cola Export Corporation, the Equitable Life Assurance Society and U.S. Rayonier, Incorporated. He was a trustee of Agnes Scott College, the Berry Schools of Mt. Berry, Ga., the Atlanta Art Association and the Southern Research Institute of Birmingham, Ala. He was chairman of the board of trustees of Henrietta Egleston Hospital for Children in Atlanta. He was a member of the American Bar Association and was a vice president in 1922. He also belonged to the Georgia State and Atlanta Bar Associations. He was a Democrat and a Presbyterian. He was a member of the Capital City, Piedmont Driving, Rotary and The Ten Clubs. He continued his interest in public affairs after retirement from an active business and legal career.

He was property manager of the First National Bank and the First Trust and Savings Bank in Miami, Florida, for several years. In 1929 he joined the textiles industry, and he has served in many capacities since that time. He has been associated with over a dozen textile mills in Georgia and South Carolina, and he is a director of the Textile Broadcasting Company, the Liberty Mutual Insurance Company and the Cotton Textile Institute. He has served as vice president and president of the South Carolina Textile Manufacturers Association. He is a member of numerous civic and professional organizations including the International Rotary Club, the Newcomen Society, the American Cotton Manufacturers Institute and the Cotton Manufacturers Association of South Carolina. He belongs to the Phi Delta Theta and Phi Kappa Phi fraternities.

ALAN B.¹⁰ and WINSTON H.¹⁰ Sibley attended Clemson College and operated a cattle farm on land that once belonged to their grandfather J.L. SIBLEY⁸ near Milledgeville, Ga.
