Dear Mr. Fairey,

Mr. P. Ulmer Savage of Augusta, Ga. has referred me to you as President of The Fairey Family Association for information which he feels you can either provide or for reference to someone who may be able to help me. As nearly as I have been able to determine the following is a brief account of my Fairey ancestry which I should like to have confirmed by some historian in your family:

"MARIAH FAIREY, born 8 July 1801, daughter of John and Margaret Fairey (John Fairey appears in 1790 Census in Crangeburgh Dist., S. C. apparently recently married:"1 male 16/up, 1 female") married 15 Apr. 1819 NATHANIEL BYRD, born 6 Mar. 1792, died 30 Nov. 1850, son of Nathaniel and Flora Byrd (Nathaniel Byrd appears in 1790 Census in Orangeburgh Dist. "1 male 16/up, I malele under 16, 2 females", apparently he was the son of Nathaniel Byrd who also appears in 1790 Census in Orangeburgh Dist. "3 males 16/up, 4 females, 7 slaves") The 2nd of the 13 children of Nathaniel and Mariah (Fairey) Byrd was:

MARY MARGARLT BYRD, born 2 Oct. 1821, died c. 1848, married JUHN L. DURK, born 1820, of St. George's Parish, Colleton Co., S. C.; there two children were:

1. MARGARLT R. L. DURR, born 29 Oct. 1844, died 26 May 1870 and buried on the Brazers kiver in Texas, who married 3 Oct. 1866 JUHN JACUB FULK, born 20 June 1845, died 14 Mar. 1918 in Broxton Township, Golleton Co., S. C. where he was born; their daughter:

MARY OLIVE ELIZABETH ("Minnie") Folk, born 23 Nov. 1868, died 15 Sept. 1895 in Orange, Texas where her epitaph remains in Evergreen Cemetery; she married her cousin, ELLISON CAPERS Folk (1869-1933) and they were my mother's parents.

2. Elizabeth Durr, born 1846, married Joseph I. Copeland and left many known descendants."

After the early death of Mary Margaret Byrd, her husband married again and raised a family by his second wife; their daughter, Margaret R. L. Durr also died young and was buried in Texas, her daughter being brought back to S. C. where she married and later moved to Texas where she also died young leaving two tiny children. These three female deaths in successive generations have caused my mother and her sister to have lost all contact with their mother's maternal relatives. Therefore, we need someone in the Fairey or Byrd family to confirm this Fairey-Byrd-Durr connection and to tell us whatever more is known about these lines. If you can help us, it will be greatly appreciated.
