

Willie "Bill" Ferguson HR.TON HEAD ISLAND, SG-Willie "Bill" Ferguson 68, be-

loved husband of Linda Ann Hornbeak Ferguson, was born on Hilton Head Island, SC, a son of Daniel Ferguson, Jr. and the late Daisy Bell Ferguson.

His early childhood was spent in Savannah, GA, where he attended elementary school. When the family returned to Hilton Head Island, he attended Michael C. Riley Schools in Bluffton, SC, during the time when the schools were segregated. Following graduation, he was drafted into the military and served in

the United States Army (1967-1970) during which time, he served in the Republic of Viet Nam for more than two years. While in the Army, he received numerous awards, medals and commendations to include the National Defense Service Medal, the Viet Nam Campaign Medal, Viet Nam TET 69 Service Medal, Viet Nam Counteroffensive PH IV, V, VI and TET Counteroffensive Award as well as the Expert Rifle Award.

Willie moved to California in 1973. While in California, he worked in the food and beverage industry and attended San Jose City College and San Francisco State University. After returning to Hilton Head Island in 1984, in pursuit of his goals, he developed the Original Islander, Inc., established The Island Gardner landscaping company and later the Ferguson Community Development Corporation.

Willie was elected to represent Ward 1 on the Hilton Head Town Council in 1993 and served for 19 years until 2012. He was the longest serving member of Town Council. His number one concern for the citizens of the Island was the lack of water and sewer services in Ward 1 and unpaved roads across the Island. Protecting and preserving Native Islander property was also of utmost importance to him. While on Town Council, he proposed and voted for changes intown zoning, land management laws and permitting processes that allowed property owners to develop their property.

Willie was an avid gardener who also enjoyed the game of golf and has played in local charitable tournaments. He was a loving and devoted husband, father and grandfather, a warrior and activist, with an endless untiring passion for the Island. In addition to his mother, he was
