Note ANN Black (6 Dec. 1768) daughter of James 2nd Rachel (Adams) Black married 21 Dec. 1788, Thomas Bowman, Bch She married 2nd. John Bythewood. Mrs. Jenkins' chyck family was connected to the Bowmans through the Adasks in some way. ANN Fickling, d2d. of Joseph 2nd Eliza (Bowman) Fickling, who married John Fripp was related to our Talbird family, we used to call her "Cousin ANNIE". After the death of Mr. William Johnson Verdier's wife Cousin ANNIE took of the Verdier family.

I can vaguely remember her, have never figured the relationship.

Note. As you see There were two "Joseph Porters". Mary Taftbird who married a Joseph Porter was my grandfather's (FRANKLIN Taftbird) aunt. Their daughter ANN married W^m C. Danner. The Chas. E. Danner I wrote you about was the son of William Porter Danner and Eliza Mary Johnson. Howard Danner who owns the store on Bay street was the son of Henry Taftbird Danner and M^{abel} Ellis. Mrs. D. W. Rose, who lives on the road to Port Royal, was the daughter of Julia Danner who married Mr. M. O'D. White. The Porter lot in St. Helen's Church yard is near Col. Thos. Taftbird's lot. Both Joseph Porters' evidently owned the same lot.

I have checked the Rhodes data you gave me re John and Thomas Rhodes and have not found any reference to Julia Rhodes. I would like to have the Rhodes family data, as soon as I find time I will make a copy of all I have and will send it to you, perhaps when you "find the time" you will kindly supply the missing links.
