JACOB LEVY ENLISTED AS A PRIVATE IN CO. D., 24TH INFANTRY, CONFEDERATE STATES ARMY, 9 APRIL 1862. IN OCTOBER 1862 HE WAS PROMOTED TO 5TH SGT AND IN AUGUST 1863 TO 3RD SGT. IN OCT. 1863, HE WAS COMMISSIONED 2ND LT. AND IN FEB. 1864 WAS PROMOTED TO 1ST LT., ON 23 DEC. 1858 HE MARRIED ELIZABETH ANNE WEISSINGER.

ELIZABETH ANN WEISSINGER IS THE DAUGHTER OF JOHANNES (JOHN) WEISSINGER 2/13/1801 -12/21/1843, AND HIS WIFE MARTHA MELDRED ZEIGLER B:12/2/1815 D:6/18/1858, MARTHA MELDRED IS THE DAUGHTER OF JACOB ZEIGLER B:8/10/1782 D:8/28/1838 AND MARRIED 1805 TO ANNE PENDARVIS B:6/24/1791 D:12/7/1861. ANNE PENDARVIS IS THE DAUGHTER OF JOSEPH & ANN (SALLEY) PENDARVIS. JACOB ZEIGLER IS SON OF MICHAEL ZEIGLER 1747-1809 (REV. WAR PATRIOT, SEE DAR PATRIOT INDEX, VOL I, P. 771) AND MARRIED IN C.1771 MARTHA PICOT 1750-1794. MARTHA PICOT WAS A FRENCH HUGUENOT & QUALIFIES FOR HUGUENOT SOCIETY; SEE TRANSACTIONS OF HUGUENOT SOCIETY NO. 87 PP. 83-95 AND NO. 88 PP. 99-106; NOTE ESPECIALLY P. 103. MICHAEL ZEIGLER IS THE SON OF FREDERICK (FAITS) ZEIGLER. HE HAD A 15 MARCH 1753 PETITION DECLARED HE CAME FROM ROTTERDAM, HOLLAND AND WAS SON OF DAVID ZEIGLER; BORN HEYSTEMM, GERMANY. FREDERICK ARRIVED SC 1752 ABOARD SHIP ELIZABETH WITH HIS WIFE & FIVE CHILDREN; HE HAD GRANT OF 250 ACRES 3 SEPT. 1754 ON MINE BRANCH OF CONGAREE RIVER AND AMELIA TOWNSHIP.

THE 1860 CENSUS SHOWS JACOB LEVY & ELIZABETH ANN WEISSINGER WITH A 2 YEAR OLD CHILD NAMED HENRIETTA M. HUTTO.THIS IS THE CHILD OF MARTHA MELDRED ZEIGLER AND HER SECOND HUSBAND, A HUTTO. SD, THE CHILD IS ACTUALLY HER HALF SISTER.

BEFORE THE CIVIL WAR, JACOB LEVY WOULD SIT AND WRITE ABSOLUTELY BEAUTIFUL POETRY AND LETTERS TO HIS "THEN INTENDED" "MISS LIZZY" WHO LATER BECAME HIS WIFE. HE WAS TRULY A REMARKABLE MAN WITH QUILL AND INK.

JACOB LEVY AND ELIZABETH ANN LIVED ON THE EAST SHORE OF WHIPPY SWAMP IN PRINCE WILLIAM PARISH. THE HOUSE WAS BURNED BY SHERMAN'S TROOPS IN FEBRUARY, 1865. HE REBUILT ON THE SAME SITE. ERCELL MCGOWAN HAS SEVERAL PIECES OF HIS PLATED SILVERWARE WHICH WERE SAVED BY THROWING THEM IN THE WELL AND FISHING THEM OUT AFTERWARDS. ERCELL ALSO HAS COPIES OF THE TINTYPES OF JACOB LEVY AND ELIZABETH ANN'S WEDDING PICTURES.

LEVI FOLK IS THE SON OF JOHN JACOB FOLK (1772-1845) AND MARY ELIZABETH HOWARD (1780-1839). MARY ELIZABETH HOWARD FOLK IS THE DAUGHTER OF JOHN HOWARD & MARY INMAN HOWARD. HE WAS IN SC. C. 1770, NEWBERRY DISTRICT, MARY INMAN HOWARD IS THE DAUGHTER OF JOHN (C.1720-1803) & MARY INMAN, THE LATTER JOHN GIVING 6 ACRES FOR WHITE LICK MEETING (QUAKERS) IN 1800. JOHN INMAN IS THE SON OF BENJAMIN (1699-7/2/1774) & JEMIMA INMAN. BENJAMIN INMAN HAD GRANT OF 200 ACRES IN NEWBERRY CO. ON 2 SEPT. 1771. HE AND JEMIMA BELONGED TO THE BUSH RIVER MEETING: THE WHOLD FAMILY WERE QUAKERS AND THOSE WHO SURVIVED ULTIMATELY MOVED TO NEWTON TOWNSHIP, OHIO IN 1818 WHERE JOHN'S NEPHEW GEORGE WAS ORDAINED A MINISTER IN HOPEWELL (1859) CHRISTIAN CHURCH AND DIED THERE 1880, AN ABOLITIONIST. HOWEVER, JOHN'S BROTHER, JOSHUA, WAS A MEMBER OF CAPT. WM. HARDEN'S RANGERS IN REV. WAR, AND MADE WILL 1810 AND DIED IN 1817, LEAVING JOSHUA, JR. IN NEWBERRY COUNTY.

SARAH COPELAND IS THE DAUGHTER OF JACOB COPELAND, JR. (1776-3 NOV. 1853) AND MARY RISER (1781-1860). THEY MARRIED 1797. MARY IS THE DAUGHTER OF GEORGE RISER, BORN C.1828 IN STUTTGART, WUERTEMBURG, GERMANY WHENCE HE EMIGRATED 1750 TO CAPE FEAR, NORTH CAROLINA, WHENCE "I CAME TO SOUTH CAROLINA AS SOON AS POSSIBLE", AS HE STATED IN HIS 18 AUG. 1751 PETITION FOR A 50-ACRE HEADRIGHT GRANT "IN THE FORKS BETWEEN BROAD & SALUDY RIVERS". OBVIOUSLY UNMARRIED AT THE TIME, BY 27 DEC. 1763 HE HAD MARRIED FRANCINE \_\_\_\_\_\_ AND HAD ENOUGH CHILDREN TO QUALIFY FOR A 350-ACRE ADDITONAL GRANT. HE FIRST JOINED THE PATRIOTS IN THE REVOLUTION BUT AFTER THE FALL OF CHARLESTON JOINED THE TORIES; LATER HE RETURNED TO THE PATRIOTS. HE MADE HIS WILL 21 MARCH 1821 IN EDGEFIELD DIST.

JACOB COPELAND, JR. IS THE SON OF JACOB COPELAND, SR. B:C.1757, PVT. 1 JAN. 1778 IN WILLIAM BLAKE'S COMPANY, 2ND SC LINE AS A REV. SOLDIER. HIS PARENTS WERE ISAAC & CHRISTIAN COPELAND. FURTHER LINEAGE UNKNOWN.

MARY ELIZABETH HOWARD FOLK IS THE DAUGHTER OF JOHN HOWARD. HE WAS IN SC C.1770, MARRYING MARY INMAN HOWARD, DAUGHTER OF JOHN & MARY INMAN. THIS JOHN INMAN WAS IN SC. C.1720 -1803 IN NEWBERRY DISTRICT. JOHN INMAN GAVE 6 ACRES FOR WHITE LICK (QUAKER) MEETINGS IN 1800. HIS PARENTS WERE BENJAMIN (1699-2 JULY 1774) AND JEMIMA INMAN. BENJAMIN INMAN HAD GRANT OF 200 ACRES IN NEWBERRY COUNTY, 2 SEPTEMBER 1771; HE AND JEMIMA BELONGED TO THE BUSH RIVER MEETING; THE WHOLE FAMILY WERE QUAKERS AND THOSE WHO SURVIVED ULTIMATELY MOVED TO NEWTON TOWNSHIP, OHIO IN 1818 WHERE JOHN'S NEPHEW GEORGE WAS ORDAINED A MINISTER IN HOPEWELL (1859) CHRISTIAN CHURCH AND DIED THERE 1880, AN ABOLITIONIST. HOWEVER, JOHN'S BROTHER JOSHUA WAS A MEMBER OF CAPT. WM. HARDEN'S RANGERS IN REV. WAR, AND MADE WILL 1810 AND DIED 1814, LEAVING JOSHUA JR. IN NEWBERRY COUNTY.

JOHN JACOB FOLK AND MARY ELIZABETH HOWARD FOLK CONT.

JOHN JACOB FOLK III HELPED FOUND AND BUILD THE WESLEY CHAPEL METHODIST CHURCH NEAR EHARDT, SC, WHERE HE IS BURIED. IN YOUNG MANHOOD HE MOVED FROM POMARIA TO BARNWELL DISTRICT, SC WHERE IN 1799 HE WAS APPOINTED BY THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATE LEGISLATURE AS "ONE OF THE COMMISSIONERS TO LAY OUT AND KEEP IN REPAIR A ROAD FROM CHARLESTON TO AUGUSTA; TO BROXTON'S FERRY AND PASSING OLD COWPEN FORD ON LITTLE SALTCATCHERS DIRECT TO ORANGEBURG".

SGT. JOHN HOWARD (C1738-1800) WAS WITH LT. COL. GEORGE WASHINGTON AT BRADDOCK'S DEFEAT JULY 1755. HIS WIFE WAS A DAUGHTER OF JOHN INMAN, PRESUMABLY AN ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY, VIRGINIA, FEB. 16, 1742. REPUTEDLY, JOHN HOWARD'S PARENTS DIED ON THE VOYAGE FROM ENGLAND TO VIRGINIA. HE WAS APPRENTICED TO A VIRGINIA FARMER WHO TREATED HIM SO BADLY THAT AFTER ONE SEVERE PUNISHMENT, HE RAN AWAY AND JOINED THE VIRGINIA MILITIA. JOHN HOWARD RECEIVED A PRESUMABLY "A HEAD-RIGHT GRANT" OF 100 ACRES IN COLLETON COUNTY, SC JULY 3/1772. HE HAD SONS: GEORGE B 1777, SAMUEL AND JACOB. IT MAY BE POSSIBLE THAT WE ARE CONNECTED WITH THE HOWARD LINE OF NORFOLK, ENGLAND, THE SENIOR BRANCH OF WHICH HOLDS THE DUKEDOM OF NORFOLK. ANY RESEARCH IN THIS DIRECTION MAY BE GREATLY REWARDING.

JOHN JACOB FOLK (1772-1845) BORN NEAR POMARIA, HE WAS TAKING A LOAD OF COTTON TO CHARLESTON IN JANUARY 1797. HE STOPPED AT A FARMHOUSE FOR OVERNIGHT SHELTER, IN LOWER ORANGEBURG DISTRICT (WHICH WOULD BECOME BARNWELL COUNTY 1798), MET MARY ELIZABETH HOWARD (BORN THERE 11 APRIL 1780), FELL MADLY IN LOVE AND RETURNED TO MARRY HER. HE BOUGHT HER FATHER'S LAND. ON 19 SEPT 1797 HE HAD A DEED OF 100 ACRES FROM HIS BROTHER-IN-LAW, GEORGE HOWARD (WHO EVENTUALLY MOVED TO GEORGIA AND HAS MANY DESCENDENTS). SO JOHN JACOB SETTLED THERE ON LAND THAT WAS VARIOUSLY KNOWN AS ORANGEBURG DIST./BARNWELL DIST/COLLETON COUNTY AND HE NEVER MOVED. THE FIRST OF THEIR TWELVE CHILDREN, JOHN ADAM WAS BORN RIGHT THERE IN WHAT ENDED UP IN COLLETON COUNTY ON 1 JANUARY 1798.

SOMEWHERE THERE IS AN ACCOUNT OF A 1 1/2 YEAR LONG JOURNEY FROM PENNSYLVANIA TO SOUTH CAROLINA, BUT NOT ABLE TO LOCATE A COPY. THERE IS POSSIBLY AN EPTON-EPTING BOOK AVAILABLE.

JACOB FOLK II WAS BORN IN GERMANY OR HOLLAND AND CAME TO AMERICA WITH HIS PARENTS. HE FIRST SETTLED AT OLD GRANBY, THREE MILES BELOW COLUMBIA, SC WHERE HE WAS A TANNER BY TRADE, AND LIVED WITH A MR. CARY IN PARTNERSHIP FOR FIVE YEARS. AT ABOUT 1750, HE MOVED TO POMARIA, SC WHERE HE MARRIED CATHERINE EPTING (DAUGHTER OF CAPT. JOHN ADAM EPTING (1720-1767)

JACOB FOLK I

ACCORDING TO FAMILY TRADITION, WAS A NATIVE OF WENNINGSTADT, GERMANY, THOUGH THERE IS A POSSIBILITY THAT HE WAS A NATIVE OF WILLEMSTADT, HOLLAND. HE CAME TO AMERICA 30 AUGUST 1737 ABOARD THE SHIP SAMUEL FROM ROTTERDAM VIA COWES, ENGLAND AND ARRIVED IN PHILADELPHIA, PA. (SEE: PENNSYLVANIA GERMAN PIONEERS 169, P. 21) AND SUSPECT THAT THE TRADITION THAT HE CAME SOUTH WITH CAPTAIN JOHN ADAM EPTING IS TRUE. THERE IS AN ACCOUNT OF A 1 1/2 YEAR JOURNEY FROM PENNSYLVANIA TO SOUTH CAROLINA, BUT UNABLE TO FIND A COPY OF IT. THERE IS POSSIBLY AN EPTON EPTING BOOK AVAILABLE. JACOB SETTLED IN THE DUTCH FORK OF NEWBERRY-LEXINGTON COUNTY, SC. AMONG HIS CHILDREN WAS JACOB FOLK II.

Rotenberg, Schwarz Wald IN SUMNER'S "HISTORY OF NEWBERRY COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA" HE SAYS: "IN 1763 JOHN ADAM EPTING BROUGHT A COLONY FROM WERDELBERG, GERMANY. AMONG THESE SETTLERS WAS JACOB FOLK WHO MARRIED FAMOURA EPTING, DAUGHTER OF JOHN A. EPTING. JOHN WINDELL SHEALY MARRIED ANOTHER DAUGHTER AND HAD EIGHT SONS. THEY WERE ALL LUTHERANS, JOINING A BAND WHO CAME FROM THE PALATINATE WITH ADAM SUMNER IN 1745 AND SETTLED IN THE FORK OF THE BROAD AND SALUDA RIVERS, KNOWN AS "DUTCH FORK". HOWEVER, IN THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE IN THE CAPITOL, COLUMBIA, THE RECORDS OF THE LAND GRANTS SHOWS THAT JOHN ADAM EPTING RECEIVED A ROYAL LAND GRANT ON 28 NOV. 1749 FOR 250 ACRES, PROVING THAT HE WAS IN SC IN 1749. THIS INFORMATION WAS PRINTED WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF EARLE STEADMAN, OUR COUSIN.
