George Riser left Stuttgart in Wuertemberg 1750, arrived Cape Fear, N.C. "from whence I came in 1751 to South Carolina at the first opportunity"; he petitioned S.C. legislature 18 Aug. 1751 for a 50-acre grant "in the fork between Broad and Saludy Rivers"; married Francina <sup>counts</sup> after Aug. 1751. Served as Pvt. in Rev. army, deserted in 1779 to Loyalist (Tory) cause but rejoined Americans 1781 and in 1781/82 furnished provisions and forage for public use. Born c. 1732, living 13 Oct. 1801; father of Mary Riser (1781-1860) who m. 1797 Jacob Copeland, Jr. (1776-3 Nov. 1853).
