GROVE FAMILY TREE

This is the (greatly expanded!) second draft of our family tree, which was originally distributed last summer. It incorporates much new information on our family's English roots, obtained from Mr. Mark Bonthron, who has done research for us in London. In addition, the following people have been most helpful in providing information: Mrs. Nancy Allen (Streator IL), Mrs. Phyllis Baker (Lakewood CA), Mr. Alfred V. Grove (New Port Richey FL), the late Mrs. Bessie Grove (Wheaton IL), Mrs. Esther Grove (Wheaton IL), Miss Joan Grove (Villa Park IL), Mrs. Barbara Hulk (Juneau AK), Mrs. Marian Manley (Omaha NE), Rev. Alfred W. Swan (Madison WI, re. the Alfred Grove family), and Mrs. Eleanor Vasak (Moraga CA).

Part I of this study will cover the history of the Grove family in England; parts II and III will list the descendants in America of Richard and Jacob Grove; part IV will include information on the Domoney, Morris, and Smith families (England), from whom many of us are also descended.

I. THE GROVE FAMILY IN ENGLAND

The name Grove is reasonably common in England, especially in London and Middlesex, where it is attested in the records of many parishes going back to the 1500's. At present, our earliest known ancestor is John Grove of Isleworth, Middlesex.

(1) JOHN GROVE

Born 1750/60 (?); died after 1800, possibly at Heathrow, Middlesex. John Grove married Jane Edmunds August 7, 1780 at Isleworth, Middlesex. Witnesses to their marriage were John Lewis and Thomas Lovegrove. We know nothing further about them at this time, except that one document refers to John Grove as a "laborer." Documents from this period most frequently spell the name as "Groves"--it was not until the generation of John Grove's grandchildren (i.e. Richard and Jacob) that the "s" was dropped entirely.

Children of John and Jane (Edmunds) Grove:

- i. William Grove christened April 24, 1785, at Isleworth. Deaths of persons named William Grove are recorded at Isleworth, March 7, 1792 and June 16, 1808; there is also a marriage at Stanwell, Middlesex (where members of the family lived later), of William Grove and Jane Smallbane (February 27, 1813).
- ii. Thomas Grove (I) christened September 28, 1787, Isleworth. died before 1799, Isleworth (?)
- iii. Ann Grove born March 22, 1789, Isleworth.
- (2) iv. Robert Grove christened April 25, 1790, Isleworth; died after 1841, possibly at Longford, Middlesex.
- (3) v. RICHARD GROVE (our ancestor), born circa 1795, Isleworth; died April 6, 1867, at Heathrow, Middlesex.
- ? vi. Mary Ann Grove b. c. 1796; died August 22, 1796, Isleworth.
- ? vii. Susannah Grove born circa 1798, Isleworth; died February 20, 1799, Isleworth.
- (4) viii. Thomas Grove (II) born circa 1799, Isleworth(?); died after 1841, possibly at Heathrow, Middlesex. It is possible that this Thomas Grove was actually a cousin, not a brother of Richard Grove.

(probably several other children)

- (2) Robert Grove married Elizabeth Domoney June 23, 1812, at Isleworth, Middlesex. It seems very probable that she was somehow related to our ancestor, Mary Domoney (perhaps an older sister). It appears that Elizabeth died at some date before 1830, and that Robert Grove married again, to Jane (-----).

Children of Robert Grove (probably all, and certainly the last four, were by his second wife, Jane).

- i. Jane Grove born c. 1830
- ii. George Grove born c. 1832
- iii. James Grove christened October 19, 1833 at Stanwell.
- iv. William Grove born c. 1836
- v. Elizabeth Grove born c. 1839
- vi. Charlotte Grove born 1841

(Information on this family is based on the census of 1841, at which time Robert Grove were living at Longford, Middlesex. There were probably older children who had already left home).

- (4) Thomas Grove married Martha (-----). They were living at Stanwell Moor in 1823 and 1825, and at "The Barn, Heathrow" in 1841.

(based on the census of 1841; as mentioned above, identification of this Thomas Grove as a son of John and Jane (Edmunds) Grove is somewhat conjectural, but probable--note children named John and Jane).

(3) RICHARD GROVE

Born circa 1795, at Isleworth, Middlesex; died April 6, 1867, at Heathrow, Middlesex. Richard Grove married Mary Domoney October 1, 1819, at Stanwell, Middlesex. Mary Domoney, the daughter of John and Catherine (-----) Domoney, was christened October 29, 1797, at Ware, Hertfordshire. She died September 15, 1848 at West Drayton, Middlesex. Richard Grove was married a second time, to Mrs. Sarah (Morris) Smith, widow of James Smith, April 6, 1849, at Harlington Baptist Chapel, Middlesex. Mrs. Smith was the daughter of Philip and Sarah (-----) Morris, and was christened May 6, 1798, at Harlington, Middlesex. She died after 1867.

Census and other records have provided quite a bit of information on Richard Grove and his family. We know that he was born at Isleworth at some date between 1793 and 1798; no exact date is available because the Isleworth parish records covering those years were badly fire-damaged and largely illegible, although the record of his parents' marriage and the births of his older siblings was preserved. Richard's age in 1841 is given as 44; in 1849 as 51; in 1851 as 55; in 1861 as 65; and at his death (1867) as 74.

The first definite record of Richard Grove is that of his first marriage (1819); he is stated to be a resident of Stanwell, his bride Mary Domoney a resident of Harmondsworth. The wedding took place at Stanwell church and was performed by the minister James Hearn, with Mary Vinson and Robert Sidwell (the parish clerk) as witnesses. Both Richard and Mary signed

their names in the register (quite unusual for that time, since most people of their class were illiterate).

Richard and Mary Grove, like many of their descendants, were members of the Baptist denomination. It appears that Richard was the only one of the Grove's to join the Baptists, since the records of his parents and siblings all appear in the official Church of England parish registers. The births of the first two children of Richard and Mary Grove were recorded in the register of the Baptist chapel at Poyle, near Stanwell, Middlesex. At the time of the birth of their first child, Sarah Ann (1820), Richard and Mary were living at Longford, Middlesex, and Richard's occupation is given as "laborer"; two years later, when the birth of their son John was recorded, they were living at Horton, Buckinghamshire (just outside of Middlesex), and Richard is called a "farmer". It would appear that the family moved frequently from place to place; Richard probably did work on various farms in the area, where vegetables were grown for the markets of London. When Richard Grove, Jr. was born (1829), the family was living in Harmondsworth, Middlesex (or possibly Heathrow, which is contained in Harmondsworth parish). The family was definitely living in Heathrow by 1834, when the youngest child, Jacob, was born. The village of Heathrow no longer exists, but is now the site of London's Heathrow Airport!

The English census of 1841 was the first to list inhabitants by name. At that time the family's residence is given as "tent (?) in the lane, Heathrow" (if they were indeed migrant farm-laborers, it is quite possible that they lived in a tent or other temporary housing). Both Richard and Richard Jr. (age 11) are listed as laborers.

Our next record is that of Mary (Domoney) Grove's death, at West Drayton, Middlesex (1848). Her death certificate states that she died of "natural apoplexy" and that she "suddenly fell down insensible in a cart travelling and died without recovering her sensibility."

Richard Grove married again the following year, to Mrs. Sarah (Morris) Smith, at the Harlington Baptist Chapel. Mrs. Smith was the widow of James Smith, a metropolitan police constable. She was living at "Richard St., St. George East London"; and Richard Grove, a laborer, was living at Heathrow. Mrs. Smith had two daughters, Sarah and Susan Smith; Sarah later became the (second) wife of Richard Grove, Jr. The certificate of marriage lists the following as witnesses to the marriage of Richard Grove Sr. to Mrs. Sarah (Morris) Smith: Susannah Smith, Phillip Morris, Joseph Hunt, Richard Grove, and John Morris.

At the time of the 1851 census, Richard Grove appears again at Heathrow as an "agricultural laborer", with his wife Sarah. All the children had left home by this time (though Jacob was just 17).

Richard and Sarah Grove appear again at Heathrow in the 1861 census, Richard's occupation listed this time as "foreman on a farm".

Finally, Richard Grove's certificate of death (1867) states that he was a farm laborer and died at Heathrow of "Pneumonia and Exhaustion". The informant was his widow, "Sarah Grove present at the death". No record of Sarah's death or later residence at Heathrow has been found. Probably she went to live with relatives elsewhere.

Children of Richard and Mary (Domoney) Grove:

- i. Sarah Ann Grove born September 9, 1820, at Longford, Middlesex; christened November 28, 1820, at Poyle. She married George Ransley June 21, 1842, at Harmondsworth.
- ii. John Grove born October 16, 1822, at Horton, Buckinghamshire; christened November 30, 1823, at Poyle; died June 16, 1833, probably at Heathrow.
- iii. Jane Grove born June 18, 1825; died September 21, 1856, place unknown; she was probably married since no certificate of death is to be found under the name "Jane Grove".
- * iv. RICHARD GROVE born August 15, 1829, parish of Harmondsworth; died February 21, 1900, at Wheaton, Illinois.
- v. Rachel Grove born February 8, 1832, Heathrow? died after 1856 (when she was present as a witness at the wedding of her brother Jacob).
- * vi. JACOB GROVE born August 27, 1834, at Heathrow, Middlesex; died October 1, 1899, at Wheaton, Illinois.

II. RICHARD GROVE AND FAMILY

1. RICHARD GROVE

Born August 15, 1829, Harmondsworth parish, Middlesex; died February 21, 1900, at Wheaton, Illinois. Richard Grove married Lavinia Morris June 29, 1850, at Harlington Baptist Chapel, Harlington, Middlesex. Lavinia was the daughter of John Morris, a laborer, and was born at Harlington circa 1828; she died October 29, 1853 in London. Richard and Lavinia (Morris) Grove had two sons: John Morris Grove and Richard Grove (III).

Richard Grove married a second time to Sarah Smith, May 22, 1855, East London. Sarah Smith, the daughter of James and Sarah (Morris) Smith, was born circa 1825, at Georges East, Middlesex; she died in DuPage County, Illinois, after 1870. Sarah was the daughter of Richard's step-mother, and also a first cousin to his first wife, Lavinia. Thus Richard Grove's son, Richard Grove, married Sarah Smith, the daughter of Sarah Smith! Richard and Sarah (Smith) Grove had four children: Sarah Ann, James, Joseph, and Alfred. They came to America in 1870.

Richard Grove's third wife was Sarah Burton, whom he married in DuPage County; no children by this marriage.

Richard Grove kept a diary in London during the 1850's, which adds further details to what can be learned from census and other records. He is first mentioned in the census of 1841, when he is listed as a laborer along with his father, at Heathrow (then 11 years old).

There are two journal entries for 1849: "Richard Grove entered police force, October 29, 1849" and "went to Clerkenwell November 6".

At the time of his marriage to Lavinia Morris (1850), his place of residence is given as Heathrow, a laborer by occupation; Lavinia was a servant, and was living at Harlington. The wedding was performed by William Pratt, with John Morris and Sarah Frances Best as witnesses. Their first child, John Morris Grove, was born at Heathrow the following year; however, Richard and Lavinia Grove are not to be found at Heathrow in the census of 1851, which suggests that they had recently moved.

Richard's journal states that he "went to 26 Lawrence Lane January 10, 1853". Their second son, Richard, was born that summer at Walworth, Surrey. Lavinia Grove died that autumn-- "dearly beloved wife died Oct 29, 1853 (buried Nov 1st)". Subsequent entries detail Richard's expenses for having the baby cared for.

At the time of his marriage to Sarah Smith (1855), Richard Grove resided at #12 Edmund Place, Aldersgate Street, London, and was a "packer" by occupation. Sarah Smith resided at Sevenoaks, Kent. The ceremony was performed at the Register Office, Devonshire Square, London E.C. by Henry Septimus Baylis, Registrar; witnesses were James Philip Smith, Martha Smith, and Philip Dickerson.

Richard and Sarah Grove were living at St. Lukes, Middlesex when their daughter Sarah Ann was born (1856), and were still there two years later when son James was born. Richard left his son Joseph a lap-desk, containing tuning-forks and papers indicating that he gave singing lessons and was the director of choral societies in London (these were very popular at the time). A journal entry of January 19, 1859 reads, "Beseley. Hymn used at Locke Chapel", which suggests that he composed music as well.

The birth certificate of Joseph Grove (1860) gives Richard's occupation as "auctioneer's assistant" (perhaps working for W. Taylor, Furniture Dealer, whose card is among the papers in Richard's desk). He was then a resident of "3 Fisher Street (Red Lion Square), Holborn, West London". The census of the following year finds him at the same address, his occupation now given as "Drapers Porter". Listed with them are two lodgers, including a 17 year old Josiah Ransly (or Ransby?) working as a "porter", and born at West Drayton, Middlesex. He was very probably a son of Sarah Ann Grove (who was married to George Ransley in 1842), and hence Richard's nephew.

On the occasion of the departure of his brother Jacob for America, Richard wrote these "Lines composed by R.G. Feb 25, 1866":

Dear Brother and Sister why leave dear old England
Why cross the broad waves to America's shore
Here dwell faithful friends here virtue and freedom
Are fostered & nourished with tenderest care
The home of our Fathers the soil that has rear'd us
The scenes and companions of childhood & youth
Where early instruction from Parents & Teachers
Has guided our footsteps in wisdom & truth
But if you will leave us then why should we chide you
It may be your fortune is there, who can tell?
May the ship o'er the billows in safety convey you
And although you will leave us we all wish you well

And when you arrive at your fair destination
The "Emigrants Home" on a far distant shore
There kneel and confess the kind hand that has led you
There raise "Ebenezer" to Almighty power
Let prayer & thanksgiving from sanctified spirits
Ascend in the name of our Saviour divine
Seek the Kingdom of God by the aid of his merits
And all needful blessing shall surely be thine
Our God is Almighty, he ruleth the nations
Through the boundless creation his wisdom is seen
His mercy the same throughout all generations
Jacob's God to his saints ever faithful has been
To the God of all mercy we therefore commend you
May his blessing establish the work of your hands
But remember in all things his vows are upon you
And he says if ye love me, ye will keep my commands
Farewell we now say, but we will not forget you
May we still be united by friendship and love
For Love's cord can extend full across the Atlantic
And through Love Divine may we all meet above.

Their father, Richard Grove, Sr., died the following year; and in 1870 Richard, his wife, and his five surviving children emigrated to America, taking passage on the steamship Tweed, which embarked from London for Quebec on June 24.

Richard settled in Wheaton, Illinois, where he was welcomed by his brother Jacob. A photograph of Richard, Sarah, and their four children was taken at Wheaton during this period. By 1880, all the children must have left home, since the census lists Richard and Sarah only, living in Wheaton; but it is unclear from this whether Sarah (Smith) Grove is meant, or whether she had died and this was Sarah (Burton) Grove, Richard's third wife. Little definite information is available about this third marriage.

Richard Grove died at Wheaton on February 21, 1900, just a few months after Jacob's death. He is buried in Wheaton Cemetery along with his wives, Sarah (Smith) Grove and Sarah (Burton) Grove (graves not marked).

1.1. JOHN MORRIS GROVE

Born May 21, 1851, at Heathrow, Middlesex; died October 12, 1912, at Wheaton IL. He married Sina Dorothea Stiansen, January 1, 1872, at Proviso IL. Sina was born March 27, 1845, at Eidanger, Norway, and died September 22, 1885, at Englewood IL. John Morris and Sina (Stiansen) Grove had at least six children: John Benjamin, Stephen Emanuel, Richard, Susana Mary, Charles, and Albert. The family resided in Turner Junction (now West Chicago), where John Morris Grove was employed as a house painter and decorator.

John Morris Grove married a second time, to Caroline Ruth Donovan, December 4, 1886, at Chicago IL. She was the daughter of John and Mahala (Matthews) Donovan and was born December 14, 1855, in London; she died November 16, 1930, at Wheaton IL. John Morris and Caroline Ruth (Donovan) Grove had two children: Grace Mahala and Arthur Ernest.

1.1.1. JOHN BENJAMIN GROVE

Born October 7, 1872 at Wheaton IL; died December 24, 1945, at Wheaton IL. He married Mrs. Ida (Hansen) Ward, a widow with three children (Myrtle, Marguerite, and Harold Ward), in 1900. Ida died in 1923. He married a second time, to Olive Stark, in 1926.

"Ben" Grove worked for 50 years as a decorating contractor, and was for 45 years one of Wheaton's volunteer firemen. He died on his way to a fire, and members of the fire department served as his pall bearers. He had no children of his own.

1.1.2. STEPHEN EMANUEL GROVE

Born February 25, 1874, at Chicago IL; died June 1, 1945, at Lake Zurich IL. He was married first to Alice Conner, and second to Mabel (-----); there were no children by either marriage. Stephen Grove worked as a decorator in Chicago.

1.1.3. RICHARD GROVE

Born April 16, 1876; died October 10, 1943. Richard was married first to Alice Hicks, and second to Myrna (-----). Richard Grove had three children: Margaret, Robert, and another son.

Born April 30, 1878, at Wheaton IL; died May 23, 1883.

1.1.5. CHARLES MORRIS GROVE

Born March 28, 1880, at Turner Junction (West Chicago) IL; died June 13, 1882, at Turner Junction. Possibly there were two sons who died young, named Charles and Morris; but existing records suggest they were the same person.

1.1.6. ALBERT GROVE

Born April 1, 1883 at Turner Junction IL; died May 14, 1958 at Aurora IL. He married Florence Shafer in 1929. Bert and Florence had no children.

"Bert" Grove went to sea at the age of 16 and eventually rose to the rank of captain in the merchant marine. He visited the Soviet Union, among other places, before returning to Wheaton in 1928; he then worked as a painter and decorator for 20 years.

1.1.7. GRACE MAHALA GROVE

Born circa 1888, at Chicago IL; died circa 1965 ("age 77") at St. Petersburg FL. She married Louis C. Thaon. Louis and Grace had one daughter, Ruth.

Ruth married (husband's name unknown), and had a son and a daughter.

1.1.8. ARTHUR ERNEST GROVE

Born May 10, 1890, at Chicago IL; died March 18, 1949, at Wheaton IL. Arthur married Bessie Marie Lambe, April 25, 1919, in Chicago IL. Bessie, the daughter of William V. and Sarah Jane (Wallace) Lambe, was born May 29, 1894, in Warrenville IL; died May 26, 1986, at Streator IL. Arthur and Bessie had four children: Arthur Scott, Phyllis Eileen, Barbara Ann, and Nancy Miriam.

1.1.8.1. ARTHUR SCOTT GROVE

Born August 27, 1920; married Helen Oberg, July 14, 1944. They reside in Wheaton IL. Scott and Helen had five children: Vickie Lee, Gerald Scott, James Arthur, Ronald Ernest, and Nancy Lynn.

1.1.8.1.1. VICKIE LEE GROVE

Born November 10, 1949; married Arthur "Biff" Baer, September, 1971. They were divorced in April, 1974. Vickie resides in Houston TX.

Born February 28, 1952; married Lisa Potter, May 10, 1975. Jerry and Lisa reside in Dixon CA.

Born November 18, 1957; married Timberlee Tamraz, May 24, 1980. Ronald and Timberlee reside in West Germany and have two daughters: Callyson Taylor and Breanne Kelsey.

Born September 12, 1922; married Robert Wallace Baker, July 4, 1948. Robert and Phyllis reside in Lakewood CA. They have four children: Christopher Alan, Barbara Lynn, Jane Ellen, and Andrew Wayne.

Born November 29, 1951. Christopher resides in Lakewood CA, and has a daughter, Trisa Renee (Morey).

Born January 23, 1952; married Daniel Walsh, August 8, 1980. Daniel and Pamela reside in Wheaton IL and have a daughter, Mollie Christina.

Alfred and Carrie (Brown) Grove had two children: Marie and Paul Burton.

III. JACOB GROVE AND FAMILY

2. JACOB GROVE

Born August 27, 1834, at Heathrow, Middlesex; died October 1, 1899, at Wheaton IL. Jacob Grove married Elizabeth Crane, August 8, 1856, at the Register Office, East London. Elizabeth was the daughter of Joseph Crane, a farmer, and was born circa 1833. She was living at Windlesham, Surrey at the time. Jacob was then residing at 5 (Wells?) Street, Cripplegate, London and was employed as a "warehouse porter". The wedding was performed by James Reeve, registrar, with George (Pear?) and Rachel Grove (Jacob's sister) as witnesses. A photograph of Jacob and Elizabeth, taken in London, is our only picture of him.

Jacob and Elizabeth Grove emigrated to America in 1866, probably soon after the date of Richard's poem (February 25). They were living in Wheaton at the time of the 1870 census, with Jacob's occupation then given as "farmer". Richard Grove and family joined them in Wheaton that same year.

Elizabeth Grove died at some time between 1870 and 1880. Jacob and Elizabeth had no children, as far as is known. Jacob is found in the census of 1880 with the family of Samuel S. Wilcox in Winfield township. His occupation is given as "hired man/farm laborer".

Jacob Grove married a second time, to Amy Eva Mann, January 25, 1882, at Wheaton IL. Eva was the daughter of Sylvanus and Eleanor (Brazie) Mann and was born July 30, 1853 at Summit, Schoharie County NY and died May 25, 1926 in Wheaton. Their wedding was performed by Charles Blanchard, the president of Wheaton College, in his home.

Jacob and Eva Grove were living in Geneva IL at the time their son Ralph was born (1884); Jacob was a merchant and machinist by occupation. At the time of Eva's birth (1892) they were again living in Wheaton. Jacob commuted by train to Chicago, where he worked for many years in the shipping department of Carson Pirie Scott Co., apparently until shortly before his death. Jacob attended College Church, which then met in Blanchard Hall on the college campus, and it was he that rang the tower bell to summon people to the services. Jacob and Eva lived in a house on Wesley Street by the tracks (no longer standing), which had belonged to Eva's father since about 1860. Bessie (Lambe) Grove (see 1.1.8.) was living next door at the time of Jacob's final illness, and remembered being asked to play quietly, as Mr. Grove was very ill.

Jacob Grove's funeral sermon was preached by Prof. H.A. Fischer. Jacob and Eva (Mann) Grove are both buried in Wheaton Cemetery.

Jacob and Eva had two children: Ralph Bryant and Eva Almeda.

2.1. RALPH BRYANT GROVE

Born April 26, 1884 at Geneva IL; died January 23, 1971 at Winfield IL. Ralph married Alice Eliza Hitchcock, July 13, 1912 at Chicago IL. Alice, the daughter of John Milton and Mary Jane (Moore) Hitchcock, was born November 23, 1890 in Chicago; died May 10, 1968 in Wheaton.

Ralph Grove worked for the telephone company in Chicago, and was subsequently a farmer and Methodist minister in rural Michigan. He returned to Wheaton in 1936 and had his own business, the Grove Heating and Appliance Company, on Front Street. He later worked as an accountant for automotive parts dealers in Chicago and in Elgin IL.

Ralph and Alice (Hitchcock) Grove had five children: John Harold, Paul Frederick, James Rodney, Donald Hitchcock, and Mary Alice.

b) THE MORRIS & SMITH FAMILIES

Philip Morris, a laborer, resided in the parish of Harlington, Middlesex. Parish records record the death there on June 27, 1819 of Susannah Morris, age 83, "of old age"; this Susannah Morris may well have been the mother of Philip Morris.

This William Hill/Mill had been a witness to the wedding of John Morris to Eliza Best the previous year, along with an unidentified "Emma Morris". Witnesses to the wedding of William Hill/Mill to Mary Morris were John and Philip Morris (i. and ii. above), Sarah Welton, and Catharine Thomson.
- viii. George Morris chr. November 7, 1802, Harlington
- ix. Phillis Morris b. July 27, 1804, Harlington (twin)
d. September 14, 1804, Harlington
- x. Phebe Morris b. July 27, 1804, Harlington (twin)
d. September 16, 1806, Harlington
(both Phillis and Phebe Morris were christened at Harlington, August 26, 1804)
