William Coleman Harris, born 13 Oct. 1818 in TN, married 1841 in Hardin Co., TN Martha Louisa Milam, born 1822 in TN; their eleven children were all born in Hardin Co., TN but in 1879 they moved to Franklin Co., Arkansas in a wagon train with Milam and Harris relatives. William Coleman Harris was a member of the Masonic Order as shown by its insignia on his tombstone in Lowe's Creek Cemetery, Franklin Co., Ark.; he died 19 May 1881. His widow lived with her children until her death near Cecil, Ark. 6 July 1922; her tombstone, beside that of her husband, reads: "Martha L. Harris/July 6, 1922/ Age 100 years".
