16 Dec. 1791 - Purchased from Robert Hall and wife, Mary, for 130, 100a. on both sides of North Creek. Deed Bk. D.p.161

22 Aug. 1793 - Purchased from Jesse Owley & wife, Elizabeth, for L20, 50a. on the north side of North Creek. Benjamin & John Milam were witnesses. Deed Bk. E, p. 40

17 Oct. 1797 - Thomas(X, his mark)Milam sold to Jesse Motes for £10, the above 50a. Elizabeth Milam, wife, released her right of dower. Deed Bk. G, p. 512.

29 Dec. 1800 - Thomas(X, his mark) Milam and Elizabeth, his wife, sold to John Milam, Jr.\* for \$250, 100a. on both sides of North Creek, part of a grant to Cargill. Wit: Bartlett Milam. Deed Bk. G, p. 226.

\*This John Milam, "Jr." was probably the son of Bartlett.
Descendants say: John Page Milam. There is no documentation in Laurens Co. records that his name was Page or even "P". He is always referred to as John Milam, Jr. and later, after the removal of Capt. John Milam, as John Milam, Sr. In no record is he referred to as: John Page or John P.

7 Feb. 1811 - Thomas(X, his mark)Milam witnessed a deed by which Charles Little and wife sold land on Duncan Creek to James Leake. Deed Bk. J, 215.

(The above entries are from early deed books and will books to 1820. Thomas Milam may have died in Laurens Co. but there are no wills or probate records for him. There are other early entries for a Thomas Milam who appears to have been Thomas, son of Bartlett.)

10ct. 1816 - Coleman Milam to Oswell Beavis (Beavers) for \$22, 24a., part of 126a. laid out to Caleb Day, now owned by James Leake, and adj. Charles Little. Deed Bk. K, p. 239. (No dower release. Records do not show how Coleman Milam obtained the above tract of land. No other entry for Coleman Milam.) \* Actually "DAYIS.
