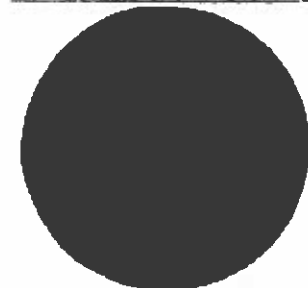

Heinrich HOrger of Oberhasel emigrated to Carolina with his wife and children some years ago. His daughter Barbara remained in this country and entered service as a maid in the canton of Zurich. She has now had an illegitimate child and wishes to go to her father in Carolina with it. Barbara requests permission to emigrate and to take with her her property of 90 crowns. The government puts no obstacles in her way and instructs the Amtmannn to deduct the tax due from the capital. 1742 Feb. 21 Ulrich Berger, as guardian of Barbara Horger who has emigrated to Carolina, pays the usual emigration tax on 108 crowns with 10 crowns, 20 batzen. 1742 Barbara Horger accompanied Peter Huber to Carolina. 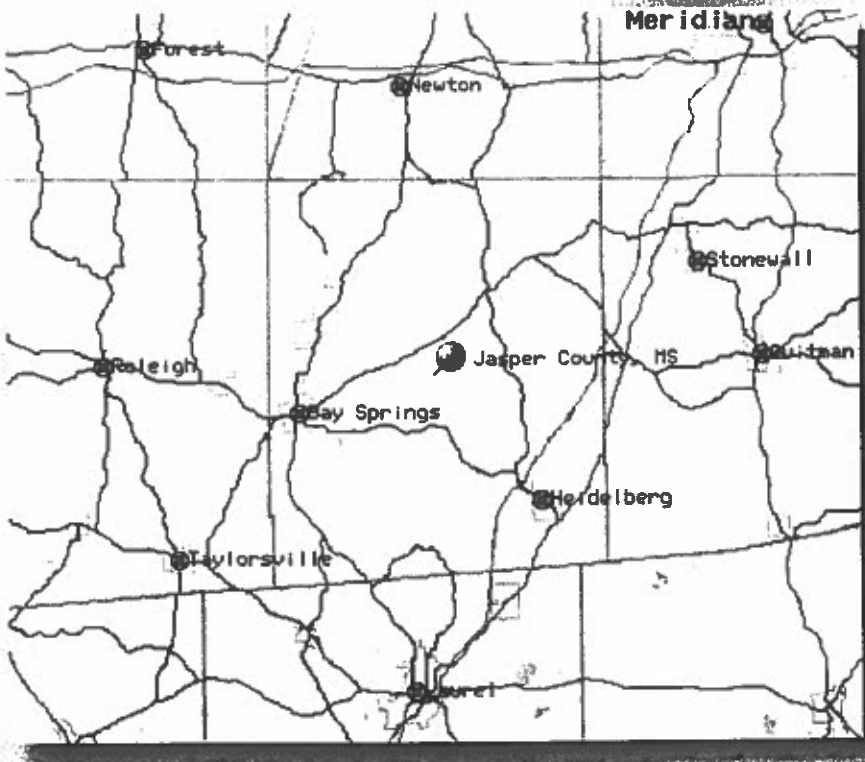


