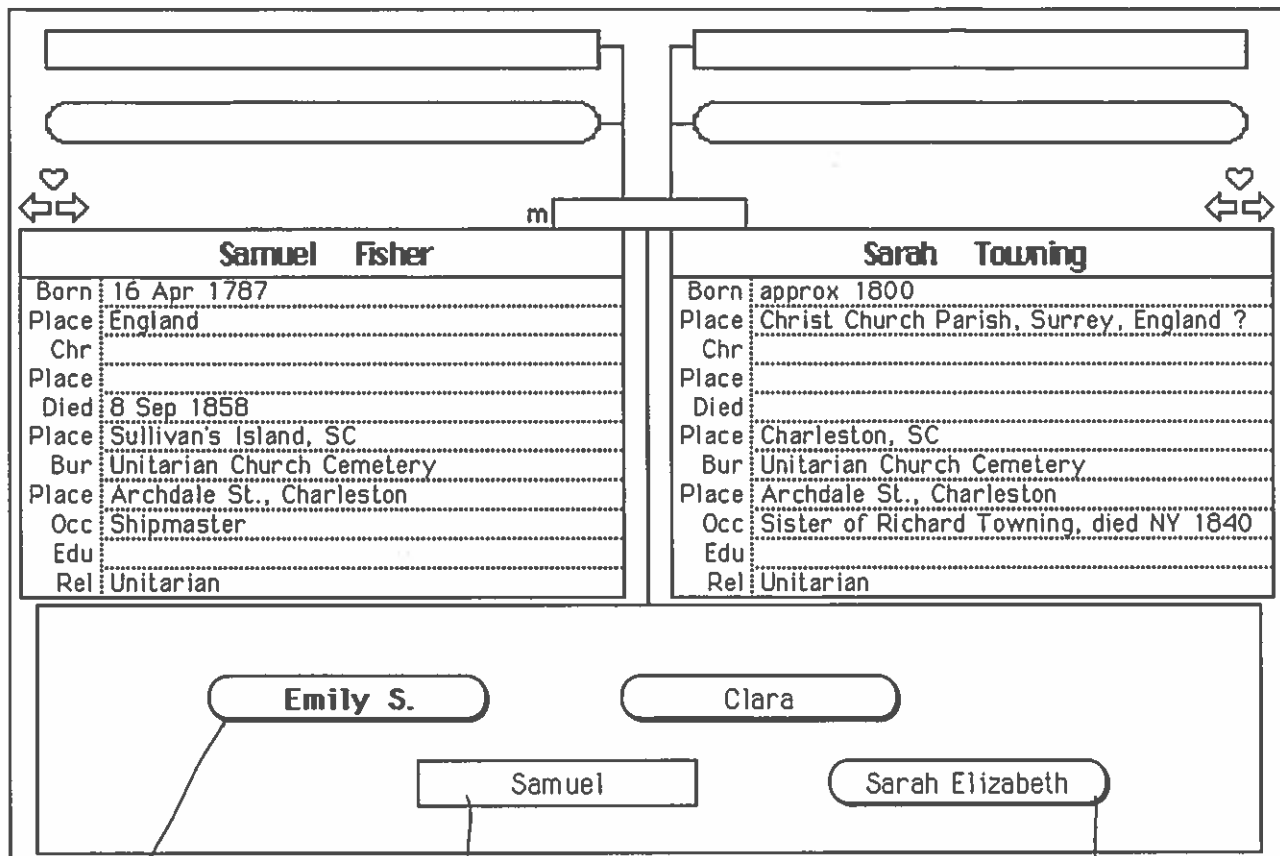

WILL OF

THOMAS HORSEY

South Carolina.

14 N. E. 16.

In the Name of God Amen, I Thomas Horsey of Philips Parish, being low and weak in body, but of sound disposing mind and memory, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament. I bequeath my body to the dust, and my soul to the mercies of Almighty God, and as to the property which I shall die possessed of I make thereof the following disposition. My will and desire is that all my just debts and funeral expences be punctually discharged and that my Executors herein after named do appropriate to that purpose the cash that may be by me at my death as well as the money due to me and the produce of my property, and not to have recourse to a sale unless it shall be found that the above funds are inadequate to the discharge of the demands against me. It is my will and desire is that my Executors do pay to my beloved wife the annual sum of seventy pounds for her maintenance during her life in lieu and full compensation for her dower and all other demands or charges on my Estate, with which sum

Twenty pounds I do hereby charge the annual proceeds of
Estate both real and personal during the life of my said
wife for her benefit. Item my will and desire is that my exe-
cutors do appropriate the residue of the ¹income of my Estate
to the support and maintenance of my Son and of ²my other child
or children which I may hereafter have born, until he or they
shall attain the age of twenty one years or day of marriage.

And as to the rest and residue of my Estate both real and per-
sonal whatsoever and wheresoever I give devise and bequeath
the same to be equally divided among and between such child
or children of mine now living or hereafter to be born as
shall attain his her or their age of twenty one years or day
of marriage and to his her and their heirs and assigns for
ever, but in case no child of mine shall attain the age of
twenty one years or day of marriage, then I give devise and
bequeath the said residue of my Estate to be equally divided

between Samuel Barksdale Jones, Elizabeth Martha Jones and
John Townsend Jones Children of my good friends Thomas and
Abigail Jones, to them their heirs, executors and adminis-
trators for ever. Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute
and appoint my friends Samuel Barksdale Jones and William
Johnson Junior Executors of this my last Will and Testament,
hereby revoking and annulling all former Wills and declaring
this to be my last Will and Testament.
