In the 1880 Beaufort; census: 1 male 10/16, 3males 16/26, 1 male over 45, 1 female under 10, 1 female 10/16. On 18 Jul 1809 Mr Elias Jaudon died at his plantation on the Black Swamp of a long and tedious illness, which he bore with Christian fortitude, in his 71st year.
