

BENJAMIN WALTER JENKINS, 5th child of Benjamin William Jenkins and Martha Ann Jaudon was born March 10, 1845 in Barnwell County and died December 23, 1903, Kline S.C. He was a CSA Pvt., 3rd Regiment, F Co - Calvary, Barnwell District. He was captured at South New Port, Ga., 8-17-1864 and imprisoned along with his brother William Kirk at Fort Delaware, Delaware. He was released at age 19 at the end of the war.

At some date between 1865 and 1869 he met and married (1) Martha Victoria Myrick (b. 1-9-1846; d. 3-27-1896). She was the daughter of: John Myrick (b. 5-17-1806; d. 2-21-1880) and Sarah Jeter (b. 4-12-1812; d. 8-15-1879) All four ancestors are buried at Allens Chapel Cemetery, Barnwell, S.C. (dates are taken from tombstones).
