Bible records show that Margrett Jaudon McKinlay and her husband were founders of Ebenezer (Methodist?) Church. One of the pastors that baptised there was in the Black Swamp Circuit. Where was it? Where did they live?

"Early Methodism in the Carolinas" Chreitzberg p. 253, chap 28: Black Swamp Circuit adjoined Walterboro Circuit. Near Barnwell Circuit. In 1851 Parsonage at Brighton's Xroads swept down to Robertsville, Purisburg, then to Ebenezer and Kadesh, up to Cave's and Gillette's, turning to Swallow Savannah, then down to Bluff and up to Union and Brighton.
