I do have several corrections or additions. On page 15-how do you know #9 James Elias is buried in Stoney Creek Churchyard? Are there stones surviving?

Page 14: #9 James Elias' son Daniel: from Kaufman we have that he died 10 Dec 1813 d.s.p. - in Holcomb, Marriage and Death Notices from Charleston Times 1800-1821, Gen. Pub. Co., Baltimore 1979 p. 255 3 Dec 1811 Mr Daniel Jaudon died, of St Thomas, age 21 yr 6mo, left widow and one child. b June 1790
(Possibly the one that died in 1813 was the ^{child} son)

Page 20: 4. Thomas Smith Robert born 21 Dec 1777, died 6 Mar 1816 buried Robert Cem., married Sarah O'Bannon. (OFC 240)

Page 29: ~~DELETE:~~ under Sarah Jane Jaudon- a. Malinda E. Rye - this was child by Rye's first wife.

h. should be - India Inez.

Page 30: ~~REPLACE:~~^e Nancy Nell Arnold, born 1873 - with:
John Wesley Arnold (31 Oct 1875-2 Aug 1940, Egger Cem., Lowndes Co., Miss) married Hattie Freeman.
