married (1) Louisa Williams on 1 Jun 1896 and (2) Ida T. Hunter c1898,
both in Springfield. Coincidence - but how many Thomas and Sarahs do we
have...

There is confusion on the births of Georgia and James W. E., so lets leave
it as is. As for the other daughter Hattie - I was able to send off for
a death certificate (full of hope naturally!) She was born 16 Dec 1884-
20 Oct 1958. Married Berry Robbins 1 Jan 1905. Her full name was given
as Hattie Gaudon Robbins, parents names unknown!! He was the son of
Reddick B. Robbins and 2. Mollie Carter. Hattie and Berry are buried
in Elkins Cem./Effingham Co. (1879-1939)
I had her obit, but can't lay my hands on it. Found it-died in Statesboro,
7 sons and 3 daus. born Effingham Co.

Back again - had to take a break. It has been clouding up, and I had to
get the grass cut before we go.

I haven't finished with all the Lawton material yet. Or the more recent
Jenkins lines. Do you need the Jenkins material back?
