Mrs. Mary Jaudon died at the home of her son Mr. Thomas Jaudon near Savannah. Mrs. Jaudon was seventy years of age and had lived a Christian life, having been a member of Black Swamp Baptist Church for app. 45 years. (SMN Abstracts 8/21/1856)

(2 Sep 1856) Departed this life on the 10th inst., at the residence of her son Mr. Thos. Jaudon, near the city of Savannah, in the 71st year of her age, Mrs. Mary Jaudon, relict of the late Dr. Thos D. Jaudon, deceased, membership was in the Black Swamp Baptist Church at Robertville.

Susan Elvira Jaudon, born 2 Sep 1854-9 Feb 1897, the daughter of Henry William Jaudon and his second wife Elizabeth Winter. She married in Jacksonville, Fla., 1 Sep 1874 Christopher Columbus Parr. Their children were (1) Sarah Annie Parr (22 Jan 1877-5 Mar 1911) married Joseph Israel Sherouse on 22 Dec 1893. They had nine children of whom 4 lived until adulthood: Louise Elizabeth (1894-1927) married William Andrew Blackmon; Anna Mae (1896-) married Richard Cross; Ruth Elvira (1900-) married Duncan I. Clark (-1964) and Naomi Dean (1905-) married Marion Bowen.

(2) Pamela Parr, died young.

Anna Elizabeth Jaudon, born 22 Sep 1856, the daughter of Henry William Jaudon and his second wife Elizabeth Winter. She married in Jacksonville 2 Aug 1878 John Dubose (twin). Their children were Thomas Henry (1881-) married Minnie Gillen; William Elias (1886-); Theodore (1888-); Harriet R. (22 Oct 1890-1 Nov 1903); Charles Elbert (1892-1893) and Edward (1895-) (this combines Mrs. Sagor's info with that of Kaufmann)

Harriet Rebecca Jaudon, born 16 Aug 1860-28 Jul 1909, buried in W. Evergreen Cemetery, Duval Co., Fla. The daughter of Henry William Jaudon and his second wife Elizabeth Winter. In Jacksonville, Fla., 22 Feb 1883 she married Francis Marion Dowling (18 Jan 1856-25 Dec 1937, W. Evergreen Cem., Duval Co., Fla.) They had an adopted son William Hampton Dowling.

Sarah Jane Jaudon, born 8 Aug 1862, the daughter of Henry William Jaudon and his second wife Elizabeth Winter. In Jacksonville 1 Mar 1885 she married as her first husband ~~Charles A.~~ E. G. Dubose, twin to John Dubose. They had a daughter Flossie, born 1886. On 12 Feb 1889 she married (2) Edward J. Seymour. They had 2 children:

(1) Louise Flagler (1890-) married (1) Frank Marine, and (2) Tom Waters.
(2) Francis Marion (1891-) married Margaret _____.
