

Isaac Jaudon (Daniel¹, Daniel², Daniel³) was born c1766 at St James Santee,
P
Prince Frederick Parish, possibly the son of Daniel and Ann (Dubose) Jaudon, III.
Our first record of him is 16 Apr 1800 when he married ⁽¹⁾Elizabeth Herrin (daughter
of Henry C. Herrin) in Charleston. They are there in the 1800 Charleston census
as "1m 16/26, 1f 16/26". In 1810 and 1820 they are in Pendleton District, SC.

The four children of Isaac and Elizabeth Jaudon are:

1. Samuel B. Jaudon was born c1805 in SC. Married Ruth McDow (daughter of
Capt. William McDow) on 14 Jun 1831 in Pickens Dist. They had one son ~~is~~
Isaac P. Jaudon (1840) who was placed under the guardianship of (Uncle)
Paul L. Jaudon in 1854 Monroe Co., Miss. Isaac P. married Polly Ann Pope
5 Dec 1860 ~~in~~ Monroe Co. Samuel B. Jaudon possibly married a second time
Elizabeth (unknown surname) and had several children in 1850 Attala Co.,
Miss.: John J. (1844), Thomas B and ^{Margaret}~~Margaret~~ (1847) and Elijah H. (1850).
2. William Washington Jaudon was born c1812 in SC. He married Jemina (surname
unknown). In 1850 Noxubee Co., Miss., they have three children: Elizabeth
(1837), Savannah (1839), and William (1850).
3. Margaret A. Jaudon was born c1815 in SC. Married William Pinckney McDow
27 Oct 1831 in Pickens District, SC. They had 2 children: William H. (1835),
and Elizabeth A. (1837. William P. McDow died 11 Sep 1837, ~~and Pickens~~ ^{Pendleton} Dist.
and his Widow married 2nd on 20 Dec 1838, George W. Mitchell in Tuscaloosa Co.,
Ala. Their children were Lafayette (1841), Georgiana (1844), Josephine (1847),
Napoleon (1851), Thaddeus (1852), and Juda (1856)
4. Paul Leonard Jaudon was born c1818 in SC. He married 20 Dec 1843 Jane Hunt
in Monroe Co., Miss. Their children were Sarah Augusta (1844) married James
K. P. Hill; Eugenia A. (1847-1885) married James M. Durrett; and Corsanda S.
(1850) married James Burns.

Elizabeth (Herrin) Jaudon died on 22 Jul 1827, Pendleton District, aged 51yr.

 Isaac Jaudon married second Martha Mitchell, daughter of Joseph Mitchell and Polly Dunlap, on 3 Apr 1828 in Pickens District, SC. In 1831 they moved to Tuscaloosa Co., Ala., and he bought some Federal Land on the Warrior River (Certificate #15,757, 1 Apr 1837; Certificate #18,429, 20 Sep 1839). On the all important 1850 Tuscaloosa Co., Ala., census, p252, Isaac is 88yr old and states he was born on Santee River, Prince Frederick Parish, SC. In 1854 ~~they~~ they sold the land and moved to Aberdeen, Monroe Co., Miss., possibly to join other members of their large family already there. Isaac died in 1856 and is believed buried in New Prospect Cemetery near Aberdeen. The children of Isaac and Martha (Mitchell) Jaudon mentioned on the 1850 census:

Children: Newton Frank (1848), married Mary E. (surname unknown); Sarah Margaret (1851) married Thomas E. Spears 23 Jul 1868; and Thomas Jasper Jaudon (1856-1938) married Mary M. Jones 6 Jan 1876.
2. Joseph P. Jaudon born c1830 in SC.
3. Warren P. Jaudon born c1834 in SC.
4. Nancy Ann Jaudon born 12 Jul 1834 in Ala, died 26 Oct 1917 ^{New Prospect Cem.} Monroe Co.; married at her father's home in Tuscaloosa Co., 16 Mar 1854, Harvey H. Roberts. Children: Joseph (1854), John (1856), May (1859-1884), James, Elmer, William, Jesse, Martha, Rosanna, Minnie, Donie, Emma.
5. Sarah Jane Jaudon born 28 Jan 1837 in Ala, died 24 Jan 1915 Monroe Co., married 11 Nov 1853 as his 2nd wife John Marion Rye (1831-1910, Beeks Cemetery, Monroe Co) son of Solomon Rye and Elizabeth Williams. Children: Malinda E. (1857-1863), 1864 Isaac Wesley (12 Jan 1860) married Malinda Irene Beeks; Franklin Lesley (23 Jul 1863) 1864 Agnes Maria Jane (7 Dec 1863), John Raymond (15 May 1867), Charles William (15 Jan 1869-11 Aug 1950) married Genoa Grant on 10 Jan 1892, James Henry (20 Dec 1871), India Inex (1875-1887), David Monroe (1879-1904).
6. Martha Elisabeth Jaudon born 18 Feb 1838 in Ala, died 19 Nov 1907, ^{William} New Prospect Cemetery, married Thomas West (1837-1909) on 29 Oct 1859. He was son of John and Mary West.

Their children: O. M. (1860-1879), Margaret R. (162-1865), John (1865), Thomas Walter (1866), Charles P. (1869), Adella (1870), Sarah Ozella (1877), Lutrella C. (1879), and Barzella.

7. Mary Ann Jaudon born in Jan 1840 in Ala., died 16 Feb 1937, Egger Cemetery in Lowndes Co., Miss. Married 7 Nov 1863 Zachariah G. Arnold (1839-1905), the son of William A. Arnold and Nancy West. Their children: ⁵William Washington (9 Jan 1865-20 Mar 1950, Egger Cem.) married Effie Kilburn (1865-1948) on 27 Dec 1887; ⁶James Eliot Arnold (1872) married Jennie Kilburn; ⁷John Wesley (31 Oct 1875-2 Aug 1940, Egger Cem) married Hattie Freeman; ⁸Judge Thomas (1871) married Ada Turner; ⁹Jennie Quilla (28 Dec 1878-2 Oct 1956 Sullivan Cem., Monroe Co.) married Alma Elizabeth Smith (1879-1952) on 27 Dec 1904; ¹⁰Vernie Zula (16 Sep 1876-27 Jun 1956, Egger Cem.) married Charles Henry Ellis (1876-1943); ¹¹Aletha Loux (16 Dec 1879-6 Jan 1963, Egger Cem.) married John W. Ellis (1881-1943); and ¹²Newton Canada (1860-1951, Jones Cem., Monroe Co.) married Inez Kilburn. ¹³The 3 Kilburns are sisters, and the 2 Ellises are brothers.
8. James Bailey Jaudon born c1843 in Ala.
9. Catherine Clay Jaudon born c1844 in Ala. Died 11 Feb 1924 in Monroe Co., Miss., unmarried.

There are possibly more children of Isaac ~~and Martha~~ Jaudon. One of the family traditions is that he had a 22 children. That is only one of the family traditions on this elusive man. ~~Another is that he was born in France and came over to fight in the Revolution with Lafayette.~~ Several people (including Mrs. Martha Rye Watkins, Aberdeen, Miss; Mrs. Christine Owens, Orlanda, Fla., Mrs. Aretha Jaudon Gibbs, Houston, Miss) have searched for many years and have not been able to document these traditions.
