

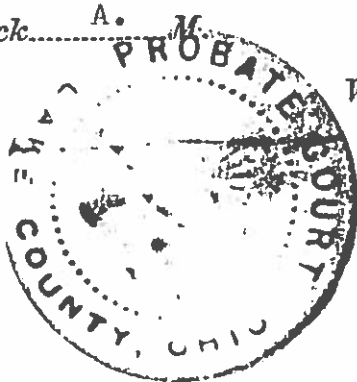

Last Will and Testament

of

John H. Kleifeld

I, John H. Kleifeld, of the Village of Timberlake, Lake County, Ohio, being of full age and of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make, publish, and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and annulling any will or wills by me made heretofore.

Item I. I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate as soon as practicable.

Item II. All the rest, residue and remainder of my property, whether real, personal or mixed, and of whatsoever kind and wheresoever the same may be situated, which I may own or have the right to dispose of at the time of my decease, I give, devise, and bequeath to my wife, Dorothy Ruth Kleifeld, to be hers absolutely and in fee simple.

Item III. In the event that my wife, Dorothy Ruth Kleifeld, should precede me in death or die within sixty days of the date of my death, or in case my said wife and I should die of a common disaster or accident and/or under such circumstances that the precedence in death cannot be determined, then Item II of this my Last Will and Testament shall be of no effect, and in any one or more of said events I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my property, whether real, personal or mixed, and of whatsoever kind and description and wheresoever the same may be situated, which I may own or have the right to dispose of at the time of my decease, to Henry Kleifeld, in trust, however, for the following uses and purposes:

For the purpose of administering this trust, the same shall be divided into three equal parts at the time of my death, one part thereof being for the benefit of each of my children, Karen Kleifeld, Kathie Kleifeld, and Deborah Kleifeld.

Out of the share held in trust for each of said children I direct said trustee to use the income therefrom and, if necessary, the principal thereof for the maintenance, care, and support and education of the child for whom said trust estate is so held in trust. Upon each of my children reaching the age of twenty-five (25) years, her share of the balance of said trust estate so remaining shall be vested in said child and paid over and delivered to her, and said trust as to her share shall cease and determine.

Said trustee shall hold, invest, and re-invest said trust property with full power to sell, mortgage, lease, transfer or exchange the same without order of court; to execute and deliver proxies, powers of attorney or agreements that he may deem necessary or advisable in administering said trust; to compromise, compound and adjust claims in favor of or against said trust estate upon such terms and conditions as he may deem best, without order or intervention of any court.


The gift, devise and bequest hereinabove provided for my children, Karen Kleifeld, Kathie Kleifeld, and Deborah Kleifeld, shall not by her or them be alienated or disposed of or in any manner encumbered while so in the possession or control of the trustee. If any of said children shall at the time of my death have alienated, charged, disposed of or encumbered, or shall at any time thereafter during the term of said trust alienate, charge, dispose of or encumber either the principal or income of said trust estate, or any part thereof, or any interest therein, or if by reason of insolvency, bankruptcy, or any attempt being made to reach said income or principal by legal process or other event happening either before or after my death, whereby said income or principal shall wholly or in part cease to be personally enjoyed by or used for said child for whom said trust estate is held and the same or any part thereof shall or but for this proviso would become vested in some other person or persons, then the trust hereinbefore expressed as to her share shall thereupon cease and determine as to said child

and all income and principal otherwise hereinbefore bequeathed and devised to her shall thereafter be held and distributed by the trustee for the residue of her life, according to the absolute and unqualified discretion of the trustee; and the trustee shall pay to said child for her maintenance and support thereafter from such trust estate such sums and such sums only as in his absolute and unqualified discretion he shall deem fit and proper.

Item IV. I hereby nominate and appoint my wife, Dorothy Ruth Kleifeld, executrix of this my Last Will and Testament, authorizing and empowering my said executrix to compound, compromise, settle and adjust all debts and claims which may be presented to or be due to my estate and to sell at public or private sale at such prices and upon such terms of credit or otherwise as she may deem best the whole or any part of my real or personal property and to execute deeds and other proper instruments of conveyance thereof to the purchaser or purchasers. I further direct my said executrix to collect any and all rents and income from my real or personal property during the administration of my estate, and to apply the same to the payment of any debts that she in her discretion may deem advisable. I direct that no bond shall be required of my said executrix.

Item V. In the event that Item II of this my Last Will and Testament shall be of no effect by reason of any of the conditions set forth in Item III hereof, I nominate and appoint Henry Kleifeld executor of this my Last Will and Testament, and I give to said executor the same powers as given to my wife, Dorothy Ruth Kleifeld, as executrix. I direct that no bond shall be required of my said executor.

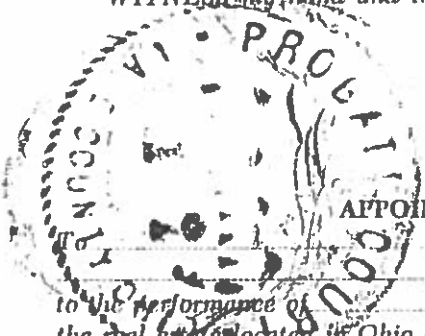

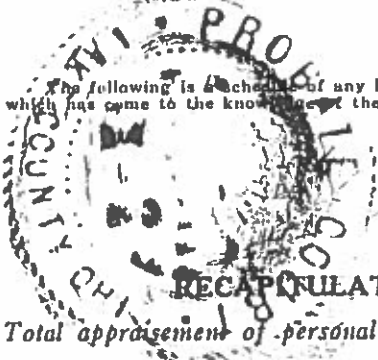

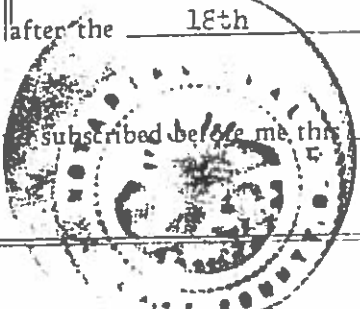

INSTRUCTIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. This form is prescribed by the Tax Commissioner by authority of Section 5731.35, Revised Code. It is to be filed whether the decedent is a resident or non-resident. Its purpose is to give notice to those concerned with the administration of the inheritance tax laws of the death and supply general information relative to the decedent and his property. It does not establish tax liability or tax value. The list of property should not be confined solely to property which is subject to administration in Probate Court, but to all forms of property which may be subject to inheritance tax.

2. Section 5731.37, Revised Code, provides a fifteen per cent penalty for non-compliance and a twenty-five per cent penalty for a false or fraudulent notice with personal liability prescribed.

3. The form should be sent to the Tax Commissioner, 68 East Gay Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. Certain probate courts may also require a copy of this notice or the date it is filed. This should be checked with the Probate Court having jurisdiction of the decedent's estate. A copy of this form or information concerning any property listed should be furnished the executor or administrator in the event the form is executed by any other interested party.

4. The form should be filed by the fiduciary or other interested party within thirty (30) days after the inventory and appraisal prescribed by Section 2115.02, Revised Code, is filed in the Probate Court. It may be filed by one fiduciary in case there are two or more.

5. If there is no administration, the form should be filed within sixty (60) days of the date of death, by the person or corporation having custody or control of property which may be subject to tax.

6. The time for filing may be extended by the Tax Commissioner for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days.

7. Under the description of property on the opposite page, the term "miscellaneous" under intangible property refers to any type not specifically enumerated. The term "other" under insurance contracts refers to any type of contract which does not constitute life insurance such as annuity contracts.

8. If decedent is retired indicate the former occupation on the appropriate line on the opposite page.
